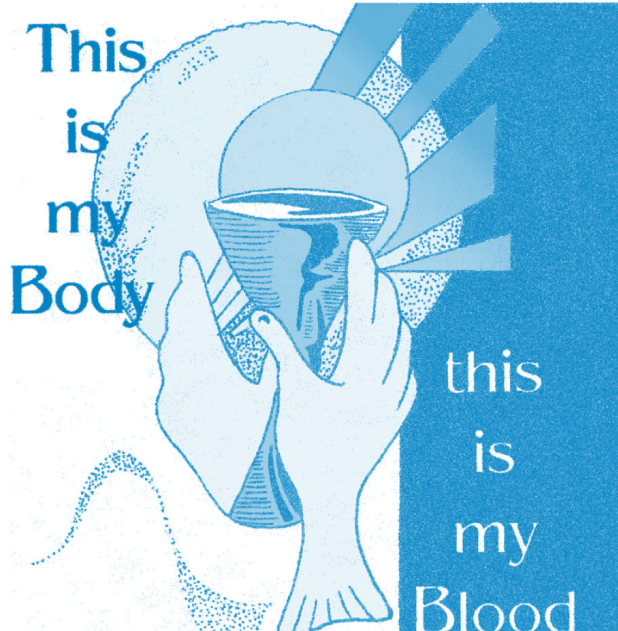

**PASTOR'S CORNER**

As we complete this special Marian month of May, here are a few excerpts from the introduction of 33 Days to Morning Glory by Fr. Michael Gaitley, MIC. "To properly understand the essence of total consecration to Jesus through Mary, we'll first need to reflect on an important point: Jesus wants to include all of us in his work of salvation. In other words, he doesn't just redeem us and then expect us to kick back and relax. ... While everyone is called to lend a hand in the great work of salvation, not everyone has the same role. ... Mary's task is to give spiritual birth to Christians, to feed and nurture them with grace, and to help them grow to full stature in Christ. In short, Mary's job is to help us grow in holiness. It's her mission to form us into saints. ... The Holy Spirit is pleased to work and act through his spouse, Mary, for the sanctification of the human race. ... Thus by consecrating ourselves to Mary, each of us is saying to her: *Mary, I want to be a saint. I know you also want me to be a saint and that it is your God-given mission to form me into one. So, Mary, at this moment, on this day, I freely choose to give you my full permission to do your work in me, with your Spouse, the Holy Spirit.*" Again, the Do-It-Yourself 33 Day Retreat by Fr. Gaitley, available as a book at the St. Marelo Store, is a great way to prepare well for a consecration to Jesus through Mary.

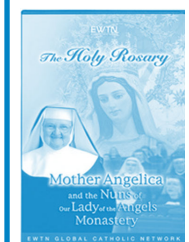
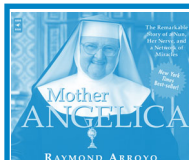

Al completar este mes Mariano de Mayo, aquí hay algunos extractos de la introducción 33 Días hacia un Glorioso Amanecer escrito por Padre Michael E. Gaitley, MIC. “Para entender bien la esencia de la consagración total a Jesús por María, primero necesitamos reflexionar sobre algo importante: Jesús quiere incluirnos a todos en su obra de salvación. En otras palabras, no es que simplemente nos redime y luego espera que nos pongamos cómodos y descanemos. ... Aunque todos son llamados a echar una mano en la gran obra de salvación, no todos tienen el mismo papel. ... El papel de María es dar a luz espiritualmente a los cristianos, alimentándolos y cuidándolos con gracia, y ayudándolos a alcanzar la plena madurez en Cristo. En resumen, el papel de María es ayudarnos a crecer en la santidad. Su misión es transformarnos en santos. ... Al Espíritu Santo le complace trabajar y actuar mediante su esposa, María, por la santificación del género humano. Por lo tanto, al consagrarnos a María, cada uno de nosotros le está diciendo: *María, quiero ser santo. Sé que también quieres que yo sea santo y que tu misión divina es transformarme en un santo.
