**PASTOR'S CORNER**

**HOW SHOULD I VOTE?** As Catholic Christians in a democracy/republic, we have a serious duty to bring the truth, love and values of the Gospel to the polling place to fulfill our calling to be *light for the world, salt for the earth and leaven for society*. The following is an excerpt from an October 2nd homily by Fr. John Lankeit, rector of the Cathedral in the diocese of Phoenix, words which are meant to help form our consciences on the most serious civil rights and moral issue of our generation, the right to life! "Every election season, when a priest addresses such topics from the pulpit, a certain portion of the population complains that he is preaching politics: 'a priest has no business discussing politics in church!' That's what some people say. But what does God say to the priest whom he has designated to be a spiritual father for the people entrusted to his care? The same thing he said to the Prophet Ezekiel: "... I have made [you] a watchman for the house of Israel; whenever you hear a word from my mouth you shall give them warning from me" (Ez 33:7). ... "The word 'abortion' has been drained of its meaning – we treat it like nothing more than a term that starts a heated debate rather than a procedure that stops a heartbeat. Many want to treat abortion as merely one issue among many – but that requires that a person pretend not to know what abortion is and what abortion does. ... - Do you know which candidate and party in this election promotes abortion and even promises to expand its availability here at home as well as abroad? – Do you know that this candidate and party intend to make you and me pay for other people's abortions with our tax dollars, something that has always been illegal? ... If you do not know which candidate and party I am referring to, then you should not even consider voting until you do know! Ignorance in this area is unacceptable, because ignorance in this area costs millions of babies their lives and jeopardizes the souls of many Catholic voters."

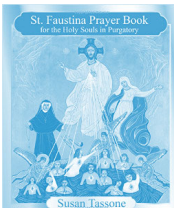

## RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

**¿CÓMO DEBO VOTAR?** Como Cristianos Católicos en una democracia/república, tenemos un grave deber de llevar la verdad, el amor y los valores del Evangelio al lugar de votación para cumplir con nuestro llamado a ser la *luz del mundo, sal de la tierra y fermento para la sociedad.* El siguiente es un extracto de una homilía dada el 2 de Octubre por el Padre John Lankeit, rector de la Catedral de la diócesis de Phoenix, palabras que están destinadas a ayudar a formar nuestra conciencia sobre el problema más grave de los derechos civiles y morales de nuestra generación, ¡el derecho a la vida! "Cada temporada de elecciones, cuando un sacerdote se dirige a estos temas desde el púlpito, una cierta parte de la población se queja de que está predicando la política: '¡Un sacerdote no tiene por qué hablar de política en la iglesia!' 'Eso es lo que dicen algunas personas. Pero, ¿qué dice Dios al sacerdote a quien ha designado a ser un padre espiritual para las personas confiadas a su cuidado? Lo mismo que le dijo al profeta Ezequiel: '... yo [te he] constituido centinela del pueblo de Israel. Cuando te hable, les advertirás de mi parte.' (Ez. 33:7) La palabra 'aborto' se ha vaciado de su significado - lo tratamos como nada más que un término que se inicia un intenso debate en lugar de un procedimiento que detiene el latido del corazón. Muchos quieren tratar el aborto como meramente una cuestión entre muchos - pero que requiere que una persona finge no saber lo que el aborto es y lo que hace. ... - ¿Usted sabe cuál de los candidatos y que partido en esta elección promueve el aborto e incluso promete expandir su disponibilidad aquí en el país como en el extranjero? - ¿Sabe usted que este candidato y partido tienen la intención de hacer que usted y yo pague por abortos de otras personas con nuestros impuestos, algo que siempre ha sido ilegal? ... Si usted no sabe cuál de los candidatos y a que partido me refiero, ¡entonces debe considerar no votar hasta que lo sepa! La ignorancia en esta área es inaceptable, porque la ignorancia en esta zona cuesta millones de bebés sus vidas y pone en peligro las almas de muchos votantes católicos."
