**PASTOR'S CORNER**

Whereas May is Mary's month, June is traditionally focused on devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. We begin the month with a teaching by St. Joseph Marello on the **PRACTICE OF MERCIFUL LOVE**. "**Charity** is an extra great virtue; but many people ruin it and corrupt it wishing to use it only with people for whom they feel some tangible attraction. Woe to us to encourage these sympathies! It will not always be a sin immediately, but there will be serious dangers; and certainly in such a way the love that Jesus recommends us, which the more it is inspired by supernatural motives the more perfect it becomes, is not lived. Jesus took great care to exclude from his love every appearance of sensibility or of sympathy or of acceptance of persons becoming all to all and always keeping in sight the pleasure and glorification of his eternal Father. It was the same also when he was informed that his mother and relatives were waiting to talk to him. It was the same with Mary Magdalene after the resurrection. **Love, love**, how dear you are! Let us try to see God in our neighbor; or rather let us look at him in the Heart of Jesus. Let us do as St. Aloysius, San Vincent de Paul, and many other saints who, the more their neighbor was neglected or annoying or troublesome, the more they loved him and took care of him. If we succeed in seeing in our neighbor the image of God, and only that, then we will find him rough and rude, the more we will love him and do good to him, being sure, in his way, that we love him only for God and so our love is more perfect and more meritorious."
