**PASTOR'S CORNER**

**ALLELUIA! We are an Easter People and Alleluia is our song.** Alleluia literally means, "Praise God!" After Paul, was baptized into Jesus and became fully engaged in the mission of making disciples of all nations, he would sum up his Easter Faith with this exhortation: *"Rejoice always, pray constantly, give thanks in all circumstances; this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you" (1 Thessalonians 5:16-18).* St. Peter would chime in with these words, *"There is cause for rejoicing here. You may for time have to suffer the distress of many trials, but this is so that your faith, which is more precious than the passing splendor of fire-tried gold, may by its genuineness lead to praise glory and honor when Jesus Christ appears"* (1Peter 1:6-7).

The best description of the state of original sin, which affects us all, is a lack of trust in God. When the creature distrusts the Creator, he/she is prone to the sin of pride, the sin of being one's own god, the sin of being self-centered, self-reliant and selfish. Of course, this sinful state makes us all miserable as we become slaves of the devil. Jesus is our Savior! He crushed the head of the devil-accuser by revealing God's infinite merciful love for every poor sinner from the cross. Through his resurrection and gift of the Holy Spirit he offers the gift of pardon to every human being and communicates his Gift of Self to every disciple. If we receive the gift of the Spirit, it means that in view of God's unconditional, merciful love for us, as expressed through the death and resurrection of Jesus, Easter Faith, that is, total trust in God, can now remove us from the state of sin/distrust of God. There is indeed cause for rejoicing here. Alleluia! Now here is the point. **We need to see the connection between Easter Faith and Praise.** Our cause for totally trusting God becomes our cause for rejoicing. Trust in God is expressed best through praise of God. God takes the initiative of so loving the world that he gives his only Son (cf. John3:16). We must receive the gift and freely respond with a new life of total trust in God. Our praise of God is our best expression of our trust in God and of our joy in God's infinite love for us. **ALLELUIA!**

¡ALELUYA! Somos un pueblo de Pascua y Aleluya es nuestra canción. ¡Aleluya literalmente significa, "¡Alabado sea Dios!" Después de que Pablo fue bautizado en Jesús y se involucró plenamente en la misión de hacer discípulos de todas las naciones, resumió su Fe de Pascua con esta exhortación: "Estén siempre alegres, oren sin cesar y den gracias a Dios en toda ocasión; ésta es, por voluntad de Dios, su vocación de cristianos." (1 Tesalonicenses 5:16-18) San Pedro sonaba con estas palabras, "Por esto estén alegres, aunque por un tiempo tengan que ser afligidos con varias pruebas. Si el oro debe ser probado pasando por el fuego, y es sólo cosa pasajera, con mayor razón su fe, que vale mucho más.
