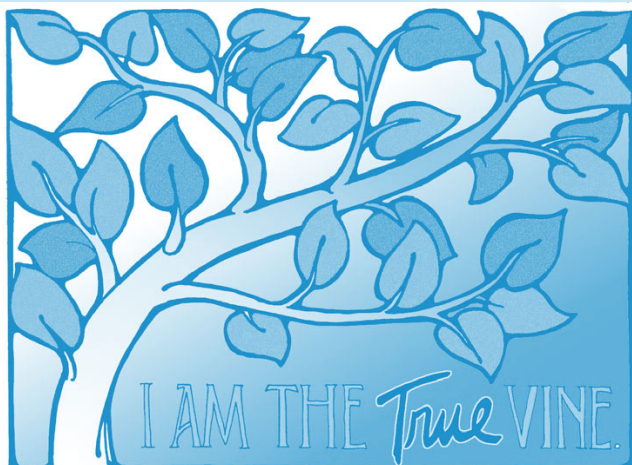

PASTOR'S CORNER

How do Strong Experiences of Easter Joy and Tearful Grief Fit Together in the Same Heart? Because I am presently being overwhelmed by simultaneous joy and grief, this will be a very personal reflection. On Thursday, 4/19, after a nine-week ordeal in the hospital in Santa Cruz, **my dearest friend, Bob Walter**, age 74, took his last breath in my presence. Four other dear friends of Bob were present. We had spent a four-hour prayer-vigil together, hoping for Bob's recovery and commending him to God's Will. Bob's end came suddenly and caught us off guard. As I made the long drive back to Madera, my emotions were numb, The next day, the dam broke. Tears and an inability to speak overcame me time and time again. I had experienced tearful grief before, at the deaths of members of my immediate family, but nothing as strong and relentless as this grief over the passing of Bob. I pondered a truth I have uttered at many funeral Masses, "where there is great love, there is also great grief." I began pondering the bonds of friendship-in-the-Lord that had been forged between Bob and I over a period of 45 years and it became clearer to me how and why Bob is my dearest friend. You see, I met Bob at a prayer meeting in Aptos in 1973, at which point Bob asked me if I would help him move his huge heavy upright piano to his new 2nd story apartment!!! Since then, Bob and I have shared many visits and many great adventures together, all in the Lord: multiple five-day glory to glory camping adventures to Zion, Bryce & Grand Canyon, Yosemite & the High Sierra, Big Sur, and Lassen Parks, nearly 20 five-day canoe pilgrimages down the Russian River, a World Youth Day pilgrimage to Italy in 2000, six years of being prayer-warriors together outside of Planned Parenthood in Santa Cruz and 3 West Coast Walks for Life in San Francisco. What is amazing is that Bob had the good spirit to do all this, and more, in spite of being crippled with cerebral palsy at age one. For the past twenty-five years Bob has had to deal with chronic congestion in his lungs and with being half-paralyzed from a stroke. Through it all, Bob exhibited a consistent joy in the Lord, thoughtfulness and concern for others on the level of heroic virtue. How did he do it? **(To be continued next week).**

RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

¿Cómo las Fuertes experiencias de la alegría de Pascua y el dolor de una pena encajan juntos en el mismo corazón? Porque actualmente me siento abrumado por la alegría y el dolor simultaneamente, esto será una reflexión muy personal. El jueves, 19 de abril, después de un calvario de nueve semanas en el hospital en Santa Cruz, **mi amigo más querido, Bob Walter**, de 74 años, falleció en mi presencia. También estuvieron presentes otros cuatro amigos queridos de Bob. Hicimos una vigilia de oración de cuatro horas juntos, esperando la recuperación de Bob y encomendandolo a Dios. El fallecimiento de Bob llegó de repente y nos agarró de sorpresa. Mientras hacia el largo viaje de regreso a Madera, mis emociones estaban entumecidos, al día siguiente, solte en llanto. Las lágrimas y una incapacidad para hablar se apoderaron de mí una y otra vez. Yo había experimentado una pena dolorosa antes, por las muertes de los miembros de mi familia inmediata, pero nada tan fuerte e implacable como esta tristeza por el fallecimiento de Bob. Reflexioné sobre la verdad que he pronunciado en muchas Misas funerales, "donde hay un gran amor, hay también hay un gran dolor." Comencé a meditar sobre los lazos de amistad de Dios que se habían forjado entre Bob y yo a lo largo de un período de 45 años y se aclaró para mí cómo y por qué Bob es mi amigo más querido. Conocí a Bob en una reunión de oración en Aptos en 1973, momento en que Bob me preguntó si le ayudaba a mover su enorme piano vertical a su nuevo apartamento en el 2° piso!!! Desde entonces, Bob y yo hemos compartido muchas visitas y muchas aventuras juntos, todas en el nombre Señor: múltiples aventuras de acampamento de cinco días de glory to glory a Zion, Bryce y Gran Canyon, Yosemite y High Sierra, Big Sur y Lassen Parks, casi 20 peregrinaciones en canoa de cinco-dias en el Russian River, una peregrinación a Italia de World Youth Day en el 2000, seis años de ser guerreros en oración juntos afuera del Planned Parenthood en Santa Cruz y 3 años West Coast Walks for Life en San Francisco. Lo que es sorprendente es que Bob tenia el gran espíritu para hacer todo esto, y mas, a pesar de estar lisiado con parálisis cerebral a la edad de uno. Durante los últimos veinticinco años, Bob ha tenido que enfrentar la congestión crónica en sus pulmones y con estar semi-paralizado por un derrame cerebral. En medio de todo esto, Bob mostró una alegría constante en el Señor, la consideración y la preocupación por los demás en un nivel de virtud heroica. ¿Cómo lo hizo? (Continúa en la próxima semana).
