PASTOR'S CORNER

THE HOW OF HOLINESS. Jesus told us very clearly, "Apart from me, you can do nothing." (John 15:5). Being in a personal communion with Jesus is the very heart of holiness. Furthermore, friendship with Jesus is a gift. Jesus loves me first, freely, always, unconditionally and infinitely. There is no greater love! How will I respond? Jesus is patiently waiting for my **free** response to his loving initiatives. Our self-gift- response to Jesus' Self-Gift-initiative is at the very heart of holiness. But, the question is, **HOW SHOULD I RESPOND?** Years ago, I used to give a teaching called, The Seven Disciplines of Discipleship. Here is the list: 1. Prayer of the Heart, 2. Word of God, 3. Eucharist, 4. Making Disciples 5. Confession, 6. Works of Mercy, 7. Witnessing the Gospel. All seven disciplines are part of the HOW OF HOLINESS, that is, receiving Jesus' Self-Gift and responding with loving obedience. But **the foundational discipline**, which most animates the other six, is **PRAYER OF THE HEART**. This is the discipline where we enter into the romance for which we were created in a personal way – Jesus is the Bridegroom, we are the Bride – in the Father's House there is an Eternal Wedding Banquet being celebrated. (Revelation 19:7). The Bridegroom's initiative is, "*Behold, I stand at the door (of your heart) knocking. If you hear my voice and open the door, I will come in. We will share a meal, I with you, and you with me. (Revelation 3:20)*". Here Jesus is expressing his Heart's desire to spend **sufficient, daily, quiet, personal, heart-to-heart conversation time with each and every disciple.** **How** will **I** respond? "Sharing a meal" implies a sufficient amount of time for Prayer of the Heart. What is a good minimum amount of time for sharing a meal, enjoying the food, and for having a decent conversation with a friend? My estimate is 20 – 30 minutes. What is your estimate? Our first step for establishing Prayer of the Heart as the foundational discipline for my growth in holiness is to prioritize this minimum amount of personal prayer time with Jesus each and every day. **How** should I pray? Is there a good method I can use to make my personal prayer time with Jesus effective for growth in friendship and holiness? The Pastor's Corners to come will address this question.

RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

EL CÓMO DE LA SANTIDAD. Jesús nos dijo muy claramente: "Porque sin mí no pueden hacer nada." (Juan 15:5). Estar en una comunión personal con Jesús es el corazón de la santidad. Además, la amistad con Jesús es un regalo. Jesús me ama primero, libremente, siempre, incondicional e infinitamente. ¡No hay mayor amor! ¿Cómo responderé? Jesús espera pacientemente mi respuesta **libre** a sus amorosas iniciativas. Nuestro auto-regalo-respuesta a la iniciativa de auto-regalo de Jesús está en el corazón mismo de la santidad. Pero, la pregunta es, ¿**CÓMO** DEBO RESPONDER? Hace años, enseñe una clase llamada, Las Siete Disciplinas del Discipulado. Aquí está la lista: 1. Oración del corazón, 2. Palabra de Dios, 3. Eucaristía, 4. Hacer discípulos 5. Confesión, 6. Obras de misericordia, 7. Testificar el Evangelio. Las siete disciplinas son parte del **CÓMO DE LA SANTIDAD**, es decir, recibir el Don de sí mismo de Jesús y responder con amorosa obediencia. Pero la **disciplina fundamental**, que más anima a los otros seis, es la **ORACIÓN DEL CORAZÓN**. Esta es la disciplina en la que entramos en el romance por el cual fuimos creados de una manera personal: Jesús es el Novio, somos la Novia, - en la Casa del Padre se celebra un Banquete de Bodas eterno. (Apocalipsis 19:7). La iniciativa del Novio es, "*Mira que estoy de pie junto a la puerta (de tu corazón) y llamo. Si alguno oye mi voz y abre la puerta, entraré en su casa y cenaré con él y él conmigo.*" (Apocalipsis 3:20). Aquí, Jesús está expresando el deseo de su Corazón de pasar **suficiente conversación diaria, tranquila, personal y de corazón a corazón con cada discípulo**. ¿Cómo responderé yo? "Compartir una comida" implica una cantidad de tiempo suficiente para la Oración del Corazón. ¿Cuánto es una buena cantidad de tiempo mínima para compartir una comida, disfrutar de la comida y tener una conversación decente con un amigo? Mi estimación es de 20 a 30 minutos. ¿Cuál es tu estimación? Nuestro primer paso para establecer Oración del Corazón como la disciplina fundamental para mi crecimiento en santidad es priorizar esta cantidad mínima de tiempo personal de oración con Jesús todos los días. ¿Cómo debo orar? ¿Existe un buen método que pueda usar para hacer que mi tiempo personal de oración con Jesús sea efectivo para crecer en amistad y santidad? Los Rincones del Párroco por venir abordarán esa pregunta.
