PASTOR'S CORNER

August 13 - 100th Anniversary of Our Lady of Fatima: Recall that Our Lady told the three children to meet with her on the 13th of each month between May and October in 1917. Lucia (10), Francisco (9) and Jacinta (7) could not meet with Mary on August 13 at the customary place because they were at the Town Hall being interrogated. The civil authorities had arrested the children and were pressuring them to admit that they had fabricated lies about the Blessed Virgin Mary appearing to them and giving them messages for all the people. Both individually and together, they were threatened with torture and a terrible death: "We shall throw you into a cauldron of boiling oil." Each of them was willing to be tortured to death rather than betray the trust that Mary had placed in them. On August 15 they were taken back home, sad that they had missed their appointment with our Lady. While they were pasturing their flocks on August 19 our Lady appeared. She renewed her promise to perform a miracle in October "so that all may believe." She told them, "Pray, pray very much and make sacrifices for sinners; for many souls go to hell, because there are none to sacrifice themselves and to pray for them." Let us recall Mary's message to all of us, that we pray the rosary daily as an aid to receiving God's gift of salvation for ourselves and for others. We are instructed to add this prayer at the end of each mystery: "O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell, and lead all souls to heaven, especially those who are most in need of thy mercy."

RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

13 de Agosto - 100° aniversario de Nuestra Señora de Fátima:

Recordemos que la Virgen les dijo a los tres niños que se reunieran con ella el 13 de cada mes entre Mayo y Octubre del año 1917. Lucía (10), Francisco (9) y Jacinta (7) no pudieron reunirse con María el 13 de Agosto en el lugar habitual porque estaban en la Alcaldía siendo interrogados. Las autoridades civiles arrestaron a los niños y los presionaron para que admitieran que habían inventado mentiras de que la Virgen María se les había aparecido y les había dado mensajes para toda la gente. Todos y cada uno fueron amenazados con tortura y una terrible muerte: "Los echaremos en un caldero de aceite hirviendo." Cada uno de ellos estaba dispuesto a ser torturado hasta la muerte en vez de traicionar la confianza que María había puesto en ellos. El 15 de Agosto fueron llevados de regreso a su casa, tristes por haber perdido su cita con nuestra Señora. Mientras pastoreaban sus rebaños, el 19 de Agosto se les apareció Nuestra Señora. Ella renovó su promesa de realizar un milagro en Octubre "para que todos pudieran creer." Les dijo: "Orar, orar mucho y hacer sacrificios por los pecadores; Porque muchas almas van al infierno, porque no hay nadie que se sacrifique y ore por ellos." Recordemos el mensaje de María a todos nosotros, que recemos el rosario diariamente como una ayuda para recibir el don de salvación de Dios para nosotros y para otros. Al final de cada misterio se nos instruye añadir esta oración: "Oh Jesús mío, perdona nuestros pecados, líbranos del fuego del infierno, y conduce a todas las almas al cielo, especialmente las más necesitadas de tu misericordia."
