- Quietly explain the parts of the Mass to our children/
- Sing the hymns, pray and voice the responses. Children learn liturgical behavior by imitating you.
- If you need to leave Mass with your child please feel free to do so, but PLEASE come back.

Remember that the way we welcome children in church directly affects the way they respond to Church, to God, and to Christ. Let them know that they are at home here.

To the members of the parish... A smile of encouragement is always welcome to parents with small, active children. This is, after all, the future generation of our Church.

Our "crying room", that is, the small side Chapel with the I Street entrance, may be appropriate for some children.
