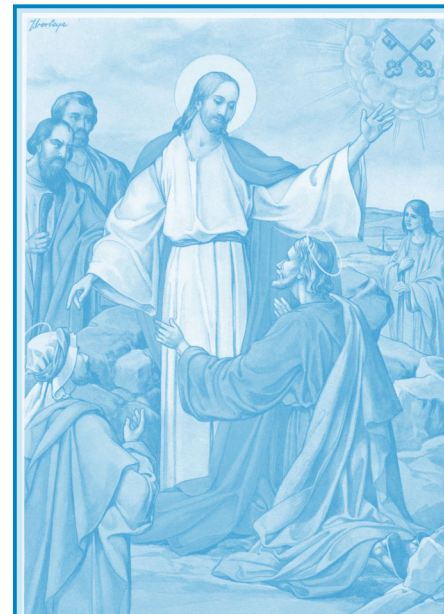

PASTOR'S CORNER

PRAYER OF THE HEART (Part 1): "Prayer of the heart" ought to be the center, the soul, the very anchor of a disciple's spiritual life. Prayer of the heart refers to my response to Jesus' desire to come into my heart and "share a meal" with me (see Revelation 3:20). That "meal" ought to consist of sufficient, daily, quiet, personal, heart-to-heart conversation time so that my friendship with Jesus can grow day by day. "Shared meal" implies a minimum of 30 minutes. The Holy Spirit is given by God to serve the "meal" and foster the conversation. *"We do not know how to pray as we ought, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with sighs too deep for words"* (Romans 8:26). *"Sighs too deep for words"* is an expression of God's love and respect for us. He refuses to treat us like computer programs. He values our free and loving responses to his loving initiatives. And that requires that he not overwhelm us with his glory. Our free desire to know how Jesus wishes to counsel us is what triggers the transformation of *"sighs too deep for words"* into the best counsel in the universe directly from Jesus, our good Shepherd. My experience has taught me that my desire to hear what Jesus desires to tell me needs to be expressed in the form of a question. If I do not ask Jesus a question, I don't "hear" much. If I ask him a question and then listen intently for at least five minutes, his answers begin to come in the form of thoughts that "ring true" to the Gospel. Jesus is true to his promises: *"For everyone who asks, receives; the one who seeks, finds; ... my sheep hear my voice and they follow me"* (Matthew 7:8; John 10:4). The Holy Spirit works best when there is structure. I recommend the structure of setting aside at least a half hour for prayer of the heart each day, allowing the spirit to guide you through three steps: 1) Ten minutes of gratitude and praise; 2) Five minutes of confiding in Jesus and five minutes of listening to Jesus; and 3) Ten minutes of interceding for others with compassionate love. Next week: why gratitude and praise comes first.

RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

ORACIÓN DEL CORAZÓN (Primera Parte): "La oración del corazón" debe ser el centro, el alma, el ancla de la vida espiritual de un discípulo. La oración del corazón se refiere a mi respuesta al deseo de Jesús de entrar en mi corazón y "compartir una comida" conmigo (ver Apocalipsis 3:20). Esa "comida" debe consistir en un tiempo de conversación suficiente, diario, tranquilo, personal, de corazón a corazón para que mi amistad con Jesús pueda crecer día a día. "Comida compartida" implica un mínimo de 30 minutos. El Espíritu Santo es dado por Dios para servir la "comida" y fomentar la conversación. "Asimismo el Espíritu viene en ayuda de nuestra debilidad, pues nosotros no sabemos orar como es debido, y es el mismo Espíritu el que intercede por nosotros con gemidos que no se pueden expresar." (Romanos 8:26). "con gemidos que no se pueden expresar" es una expresión del amor de Dios y el respeto por nosotros. Se niega a tratarnos como programas de computadoras. Valora nuestras respuestas libres y amorosas a sus iniciativas amorosas. Y eso requiere que no nos abrume con su gloria. Nuestro libre deseo de saber cómo Jesús desea aconsejarnos es lo que desencadena la transformación de "con gemidos que no se pueden expresar" en el mejor consejo en el universo directamente de Jesús, nuestro buen Pastor. Mi experiencia me ha enseñado que mi deseo de escuchar lo que Jesús desea decirme necesita expresarse en forma de pregunta. Si no le hago una pregunta a Jesús, no "escucho" mucho. Si le hago una pregunta y luego escucho atentamente durante al menos cinco minutos, sus respuestas empiezan a venir en forma de pensamientos que son "reales" para el Evangelio. Jesús es fiel a sus promesas: "Porque todo el que pide, recibe; El que busca, encuentra; ... mis ovejas oyen mi voz y me siguen." (Mateo 7:8, Juan 10:4). El Espíritu Santo funciona mejor cuando hay estructura. Recomiendo la estructura de dejar a lado por lo menos media hora para la oración del corazón cada día, permitiendo que el Espíritu le guíe a través de tres pasos: 1) Diez minutos de gratitud y alabanza; 2) Cinco minutos de confiar en Jesús y cinco minutos de escuchar a Jesús; y 3) Diez minutos de interceder por los demás con amor compasivo. La próxima semana: por qué la gratitud y la alabanza son lo primero.
