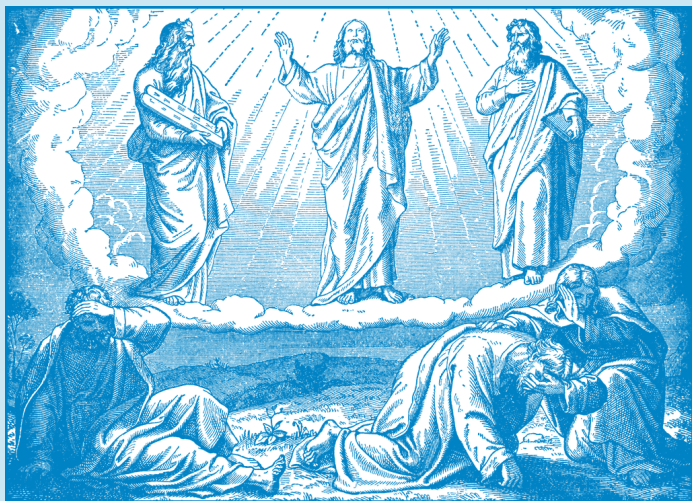

**PASTOR'S CORNER**

**WE ARE CALLED AND EMPOWERED TO BE HOLY.** Let us listen to what Pope Francis taught us in the Apostolic Exhortation, "Gaudete et Exsultate – Rejoice and Be Glad." "To be holy does not require being a bishop, a priest or a religious. We are frequently tempted to think that holiness is only for those who can withdraw from ordinary affairs to spend much time in prayer. That is not the case. We are called to be holy by living our lives with love and by bearing witness in everything we do, wherever we find ourselves. Are you called to the consecrated life? Be holy by living out your commitment with joy. Are you married? Be holy by loving and caring for your husband or wife, as Christ does for the Church. Do you work for a living? Be holy by laboring with integrity and skill in the service of your brothers and sisters. Are you a parent or grandparent? Be holy by patiently teaching the little ones how to follow Jesus. Are you in a position of authority? Be holy by working for the common good and renouncing personal gain." (N. 14). "Let us not forget that Jesus asked his disciples to pay attention to details. The little detail that wine was running out at a party. The little detail that one sheep was missing. The little detail of noticing the widow who offered her two small coins. The little detail of having spare oil for the lamps, should the bridegroom delay. The little detail of asking the disciples how many loaves of bread they had. The little detail of having a fire burning and a fish cooking as he waited for the disciples at daybreak." (N. 144). "A community that cherishes the little details of love, whose members care for one another and create an open and evangelizing environment, is a place where the risen Lord is present, sanctifying it in accordance with the Father's plan." (N. 145).

Okay, so we know that we are **all** called to holiness; that we are in this **together**; and that we must **always** act with holy love for each other in the **present moment** with attention to **small details**. In the next Pastor's Corner we will go beyond the **what** of holiness to address the **how** of holiness.

## RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

**SOMOS LLAMADOS Y EMPODERADOS A SER SANTOS.** Escuchemos lo que el Papa Francisco nos enseñó en la Exhortación Apostólica, "Gaudete et Exsultate – Alegraos y Regocijaos." "Para ser santos no es necesario ser obispos, sacerdotes, religiosas o religiosos. Muchas veces tenemos la tentación de pensar que la santidad está reservada solo a quienes tienen la posibilidad de tomar distancia de las ocupaciones ordinarias, para dedicar mucho tiempo a la oración. No es así. Todos estamos llamados a ser santos viviendo con amor y ofreciendo el propio testimonio en las ocupaciones de cada día, allí donde cada uno se encuentra. ¿Eres consagrada o consagrado? Sé santo viviendo con alegría tu entrega. ¿Estás casado? Sé santo amando y ocupándote de tu marido o de tu esposa, como Cristo lo hizo con la Iglesia. ¿Eres un trabajador? Sé santo cumpliendo con honradez y competencia tu trabajo al servicio de los hermanos. ¿Eres padre, abuela o abuelo? Sé santo enseñando con paciencia a los niños a seguir a Jesús. ¿Tienes autoridad? Sé santo luchando por el bien común y renunciando a tus intereses personales." (N.14) "Recordemos cómo Jesús invitaba a sus discípulos a prestar atención a los detalles. El pequeño detalle de que se estaba acabando el vino en una fiesta. El pequeño detalle de que faltaba una oveja. El pequeño detalle de la viuda que ofreció sus dos moneditas. El pequeño detalle de tener aceite de repuesto para las lámparas por si el novio se demora. El pequeño detalle de pedir a sus discípulos que vieran cuántos panes tenían. El pequeño detalle de tener un fuego preparado y un pescado en la parrilla mientras esperaba a los discípulos de madrugada." (N.144) "La comunidad que preserva los pequeños detalles del amor, donde los miembros se cuidan unos a otros y constituyen un espacio abierto y evangelizador, es lugar de la presencia del Resucitado que la va santificando según el proyecto del Padre." (N. 145) De acuerdo, entonces sabemos que **todos** estamos llamados a la santidad; que estamos en esto **juntos**; y que siempre debemos actuar con amor santo el uno al otro en el **momento presente** con atención a los **pequeños detalles**. En el próximo Rincón del Párroco iremos más allá de lo que es la santidad para abordar el **cómo** de la santidad.
