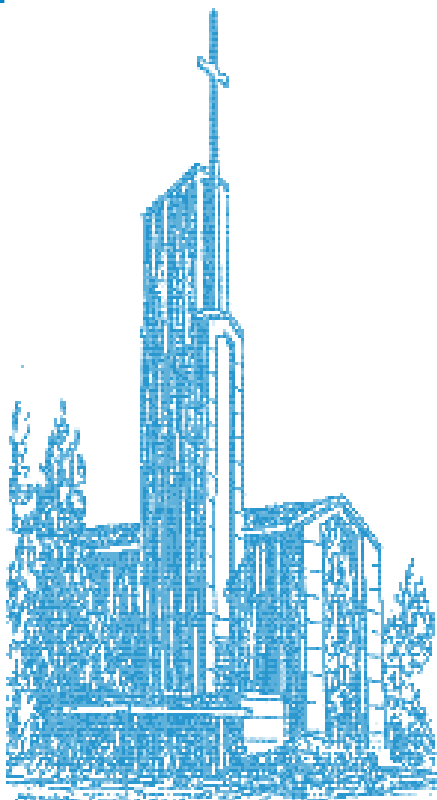

PASTOR'S CORNER

During our parish's participation in the **Consecration of California to the Immaculate Heart of Mary** on December 9, we offered the most powerful prayer in Heaven and on Earth, which is the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. This was followed by what has proven to be the most powerful non-liturgical prayer in history: the Marian Rosary. We focused on Five mysteries in the life of Jesus, Mary and the Church.

(1) The First Joyful Mystery – The Annunciation: Jesus, most humble, we love you. You did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied yourself, taking the form a servant, creating a marriage between divinity and humanity. You placed our need for salvation ahead of desire for comfort and safety. There is no greater love! Mary, most humble, we love you. You trusted God's plan of salvation over and above your need for security and control. Jesus, give us through Mary **the graces of humility**, that we may totally trust in God and then love one another as you have loved us.

(2) The Fifth Luminous Mystery – Institution of the Eucharist: Jesus, Divine Bridegroom, in this Mystery of Love, you give us your glorified Self: Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity, under the appearance of bread and wine. You bring about a "KISS" between Heaven and Earth to strengthen us on our pilgrim journey through this veil of tears. Jesus, give us through Mary, **the graces of perseverance** in Faith, Hope and self-sacrificial Love.

(3) The Fifth Sorrowful Mystery – The Crucifixion: Jesus, you suffered abuse beyond all telling, and then cried out, "Father, forgive them; they do not know what they are doing." In this way you crushed the head of our accuser and broke the power of the devil over poor sinners. Jesus, give us through Mary, who stood at the foot of your cross and endured the sword of sorrow, **the graces to unite our sufferings with your redemptive love.**

(4) The First Glorious Mystery – The Resurrection: Jesus, you rose from the dead and returned to the world that crucified you with the Gospel: 'Peace be with you. Receive my mission; receive my Spirit; be ambassadors of my mercy.' You promise to remain with us always and to establish your kingdom in our hearts. Jesus, give us through Mary **the graces to be your joyful missionary disciples.**

(5) The Fifth Glorious Mystery – The Coronation: Jesus, you crowned your mother Queen of Heaven and Earth. You came to us through Mary and you will to continue to bless every human being through her. Jesus, reign in our hearts. Give us through Mary **the graces to transform our lives**, our community, our State, our Nation and the World from a culture of sin and death to a civilization of life and love. *Blessings, Fr. John*

Durante la participación de nuestra parroquia en la **Consagración de California al Inmaculado Corazón de María** el 9 de Diciembre, ofrecimos la oración más poderosa en el Cielo y en la Tierra, que es el Santo Sacrificio de la Misa. Esto fue seguido por lo que ha demostrado ser el rezo, no litúrgico, más poderoso de la historia: el Rosario Mariano. Nos centramos en Cinco misterios en la vida de Jesús, María y la Iglesia.

(1) El Primer Misterio Gozoso - La Anunciación: Jesús, el más humilde, te amamos. No considerabas que la igualdad con Dios era algo que se podía captar, sino que te vacías a ti mismo, tomando la forma de un sirviente, creando un matrimonio entre la divinidad y la humanidad. Colocas nuestra necesidad de salvación del deseo de comodidad y seguridad. ¡No hay mayor amor! María, muy humilde, te amamos. Confiaste en el plan de salvación de Dios más allá de tu necesidad de seguridad y control. Jesús, danos a través de María **las gracias de la humildad**, para que podamos confiar totalmente en Dios y luego amarnos unos a otros como nos has amado.

(2) El Quinto Misterio Luminoso - Institución de la Eucaristía: Jesús, Novio Divino, en este Misterio de Amor, nos das tu Ser glorificado: Cuerpo, Sangre, Alma y Divinidad, bajo la apariencia de pan y vino. Ustedes traen un "BESO" entre el Cielo y la Tierra para fortalecernos en nuestro viaje de peregrinación a través de este velo de lágrimas. Jesús, danos a través de María, **las gracias de la perseverancia en la fe**, la esperanza y el amor sacrificado.

(3) El Quinto Misterio Doloroso - La Crucifixión: Jesús, sufriste abusos más allá de lo que se puede decir, y luego gritaste: "¡Padre, perdónalos; porque no saben lo que hacen!" De esta manera aplastaste la cabeza de nuestro acusador y rompiste el poder del diablo sobre los pobres pecadores. Jesús, danos a través de María, quien estuvo al pie de tu cruz y soportó la espada del dolor, **las gracias para unir nuestros sufrimientos con tu amor redentor**.

(4) El Primer Misterio Glorioso - La Resurrección: Jesús, tú resucitaste de entre los muertos y regresaste al mundo que te crucificó con el Evangelio: "La paz sea con ustedes. Recibe mi misión; recibe mi Espíritu; sean embajadores de mi misericordia." Prometes permanecer siempre con nosotros y establecer tu reino en nuestros corazones. Jesús, danos a través de María **las gracias para ser tus discípulos misioneros gozosos**.

(5) El Quinto Misterio Glorioso - La Coronación: Jesús, coronaste a tu madre, Reina del Cielo y la Tierra. Tu vienes a nosotros a través de María y continúas bendiciendo a cada ser humano a través de ella. Jesús, reina en nuestros corazones. Danos a través de María **las gracias para transformar nuestras vidas**, nuestra comunidad, nuestro Estado, nuestra Nación y el Mundo de una cultura de pecado y muerte a una civilización de vida y amor.
