**PASTOR'S CORNER**

**HISTORY, MYSTERY and MAJESTY.** Advent means "to come." Jesus has come to us in history; Jesus is with us now, behind the veil of invisibility; Jesus will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead. Our best way to be prepared for seeing Jesus face to face, either at the moment of our last breath, or, at his final coming in majesty, is to recognize and embrace him **now**, as Lord and Friend, and in every present moment. How do we do that? As I was making my annual Do-it-yourself Retreat, using Fr. Michael Gaitley's book, **33 Days to Morning Glory**, I came across this letter from Saint Mother Teresa of Calcutta to the Missionaries of Charity. The letter could be addressed to every disciple of Jesus.

*"Jesus wants me to tell you again ... how much love He has for each one of you – beyond all you can imagine. I worry some of you have not really met Jesus – one to one – you and Jesus alone. We may spend time in chapel – but have you seen with the eyes of your soul how He looks at you with love? Do you really know the living Jesus – not from books but from being with Him in your heart? Have you heard the loving words He speaks to you? Ask for the grace, He is longing to give it. Until you can hear Jesus in the silence of your own heart, you will not be able to hear Him saying "I thirst" in the hearts of the poor. Never give up this daily intimate contact with Jesus as the real living person – not just the idea. How can we last even one day without hearing Jesus say "I love you – impossible. Our soul needs that as much as the body needs to breathe the air. If not, prayer is dead – meditation only thinking. Jesus wants you each to hear Him – speaking in the silence of your hearts."*

This letter from St. Mother Teresa reminds me of the eleven-week series on the **How of Holiness** in the Pastor's Corner from August 12 through October 28. Once again, I exhort us, myself included, to the discipline of sufficient, daily, quiet, personal, heart-to-heart conversation time with Jesus – 20-30 minutes minimum. Prayer of the Heart should become the heart and the anchor of my spiritual life. If this discipline isn't there yet, Advent 2018 would be a good time to start. **RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO**

**HISTORIA, MISTERIO Y MAJESTAD.** Adviento significa “venida”. Jesús ha venido a nosotros en la historia; Jesús está con nosotros ahora, detrás del velo de la invisibilidad; Jesús vendrá de nuevo en gloria para juzgar a los vivos y a los muertos. Nuestra mejor manera de estar preparados para ver a Jesús cara a cara, ya sea en el momento de nuestro último aliento o, en su venida final en majestad, es reconocerlo y abrazarlo **ahora**, como Señor y Amigo, y en cada momento presente. ¿Como hacemos eso? Cuando estaba haciendo mi Retiro Personal, usando el libro del Padre Michael Gaitley, 33 Días hacia un Glorioso Amanecer, encontré esta carta de Santa Madre Teresa de Calcuta a las Misioneras de la Caridad. La carta podría ser dirigida a cada discípulo de Jesús.

*Jesus quiere que les diga de nuevo... cuanto amor les tiene a cada uno de ustedes, más allá de todo lo que puedan imaginar. Me preocupa que algunos de ustedes no hayan encontrado a Jesús en realidad, uno a uno, Jesús y tú a solas. Podremos pasar tiempo en la capilla, pero ¿han visto con los ojos del alma como los mira con amor? ¿Conocen realmente al Jesús vivo? No por los libros sino por estar con Él en su corazón ¿Han escuchado las amorosas palabras que les dirige? Pidan la gracias, Él está anhelando otorgársela. Hasta que puedan escuchar a Jesus en el silencio de sus propios corazones no podrán escucharle decir “Tengo Sed” en los corazones de los pobres. Jamás dejen este contacto diario e íntimo con Jesús como una personal realmente vivo, no solo con una idea ¿Cómo podemos durar un solo día sin oír a Jesus decir, “Te amo”? Imposible. Nuestra alma lo necesita tanto como nuestro cuerpo necesita respirar aire. Si no, la oración está muerta, la meditación es tan solo pensamiento. Jesús desea que cada uno lo escuchemos hablándonos en el silencio de nuestros corazones.*

Esta carta de Santa Madre Teresa me recuerda a la serie de once semanas sobre el **Cómo de la Santidad** en los Rincones del Párroco del 12 de Agosto al 28 de Octubre. Una vez más, me exhorto, incluyéndome, a la disciplina de un tiempo de conversación con Jesús, diario, tranquilo, personal y sincero, mínimo de 20 a 30 minutos. La Oración del Corazón debe convertirse en el corazón y el ancla de mi vida espiritual. Si esta disciplina no está ahí todavía, el Adviento 2018 sería un buen momento para comenzar.
