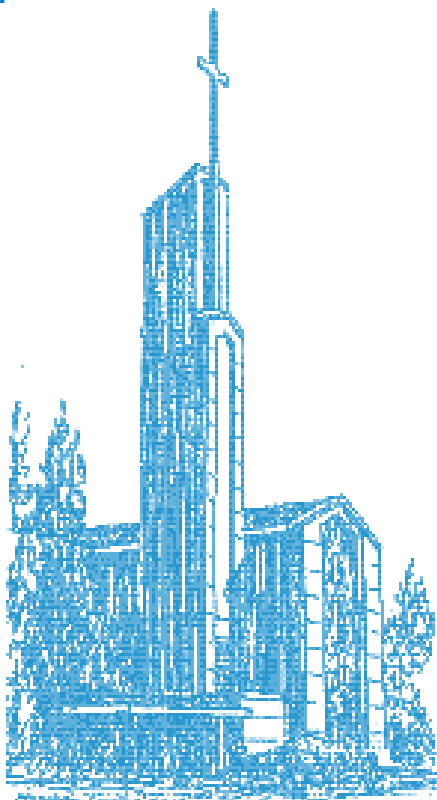

PASTOR'S CORNER

Please Join in CONSECRATING CALIFORNIA to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. WHEN?: December 9, 2017, 12:00 PM to 2:00 PM. WHY?: To pray for the conversion of California and in reparation for sins in our State. **WHERE?:** At Noon, we will gather at the Marian Grotto on the St. Joachim School Campus for Mass followed by a Rosary, Litany and Prayer of Consecration. **WHO?:** You! And millions of our fellow Catholics, including the Knights of Columbus, Catholic Daughters of America, Italian Catholic Federation, the Guadalupanos, Hijos Consagrados a Maria, Legion of Mary, YMI, YLI, Focolare, Verdades Catolicas, Fe Y Esperanza, Recollection, Jovenes Unidos en Cristo, Familias Unidas en Cristo, TOB, MYC, Edge, Esperanza de Vida, St. Joachim School faculty, staff and families, etc.

Remember: Communist Russia was consecrated to the Immaculate Heart of Mary by Saint John Paul II in union with the Catholic and Orthodox Bishops of the world in 1984. Within seven years the atheistic dictatorship of the Soviet Union, which had imposed by force of arms its human rights abuses on millions of people, crumbled on Christmas Day of 1991. Now Russian Orthodox Christianity is flourishing and is beginning to heal and transform the devastated culture of death brought on by 70 years of state sponsored atheism in Russia.
