PASTOR'S CORNER

WHAT IS TOB? In June of 1979, (now Saint) Pope John Paul II returned to Poland to retrieve a manuscript he had been working on since 1974. In September of 1979 he began a series of 129 Wednesday Audiences that would share the contents of this manuscript with the world. His original title for the manuscript was, *Male and Female He Created Them (Gen.1:27)*. An alternate title given to the work by its author is *Human Love in the Divine Plan*. The work has now been published in English with the title, *Man and Woman He Created Them, A Theology of the Body*.

In July of 1968, (now Saint) Pope Paul VI published, *Humanae Vitae – On the Regulation of Human Births*. In the face of the new technology of a hormonal birth-control pill (approved by the FDA in 1960), and mounting pressure from many persons both within and outside the Church, this Papal Encyclical set forth in clear terms that it is intrinsically evil to deliberately sterilize the marriage act. The dissent from this teaching by some bishops and many theologians in most of Europe, Canada and the U.S. was great. As a consequence, present day surveys show that 80 to 90 percent of “Western” Catholics do not follow this teaching of the Church.

Humanae Vitae inspired Cardinal Karol Wojtyla to use his philosophical and theological gifts to provide a total vision of the human person. It is reported that, over a four-year period, he wrote the entire manuscript, now called, *Theology of the Body*, in the Presence of the Blessed Sacrament. George Weigel, author of a three-volume biography of St. John Paul II, describes TOB as the “antidote to the porno- revolution and the culture of death.” George Weigel predicts that TOB is like a time-bomb ready to go off during the Twenty-First Century.

I thank God that in St. Joachim Parish the time-bomb of Truth and Love in TOB has been going off for years now in our Marriage Preparation Ministry and our Youth Ministry. We are grateful to all who help with these important ministries.



RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

¿QUÉ ES TOB? En junio de 1979, (el ahora Santo), Papa Juan Pablo II regresó a Polonia para recuperar un manuscrito en el que venía trabajando desde 1974. En septiembre de 1979 comenzó una serie de 129 Audiencias los Miércoles que permitía compartir el contenido de este manuscrito con el mundo. Su título original para el manuscrito fué, Y El los Creó Varón y Mujer (Génesis 1:27). El título alterno dado a la obra de su autor es Amor Humano en el Plan Divino. El trabajo ha sido publicado en inglés con el título Man & woman He Created Them, A Theology of the Body.

En Julio de 1968 (el ahora Santo) Papa Pablo VI publicó la *Encíclica Humanae Vitae - Sobre la Regulación de Nacimientos*. Ante la nueva tecnología de una píldora anticonceptiva hormonal (aprobada por el FDA en 1960), y la creciente presión de muchas personas, tanto dentro como fuera de la Iglesia, esta Encíclica Papal enuncia en términos claros que es intrínsecamente maligno deliberadamente esterilizar el acto matrimonial. El desacuerdo de esta enseñanza por algunos obispos y muchos teólogos en la mayor parte de Europa, Canadá y Estados Unidos fué grande. Como consecuencia, las encuestas actuales muestran que 80 a 90 por ciento de los católicos "occidentales" no siguen esta enseñanza de la iglesia.

Humanae Vitae inspiró al Cardenal Karol Wojtyla a utilizar sus dones filosóficos y teológicos para proporcionar una visión total de la persona humana. Se informó que, durante un período de cuatro años, escribió todo el manuscrito, ahora llamado *Teología del Cuerpo*, en presencia del Santísimo Sacramento. George Weigel, autor de una biografía de tres volúmenes de San Juan Pablo II, que describe a TOB como el "antídoto contra la revolución - porno y la cultura de la muerte." George Weigel predice que TOB es como una bomba de tiempo lista para estallar durante el siglo XXI.

Doy gracias a Dios de que en la Parroquia de San Joaquín la bomba de tiempo de la Verdad y el Amor en TOB ha estado saliendo desde hace años en nuestro Ministerio de Preparación para el Matrimonio y nuestro Ministerio Juvenil. Estamos agradecidos con todos los que ayudan con estos importantes ministerios.
