**PASTOR'S CORNER**

**Peace is flowing like a River.** Here's some food for thought from Bishop Robert Barron. "John Henry Newman said that what gives a river verve and energy is precisely the firmness of its banks. If one were to knock down those banks, the river would promptly spread out into a lazy lake, serene perhaps, but lacking in direction. Our moral and spiritual lives are something like a river: provided they are delimited by clear boundaries and objective values, they will remain purposive and invigorated. In the name of liberty and self-expression, our culture is frenetically knocking down every restriction imaginable - and the predictable result is that the river is broadening out into that lazy lake of subjectivism and indifferentism. We might be blandly tolerant of one another, but we lack common purpose. We are no longer adventurers on the fast-flowing river; rather we are individuals, floating languidly on separate air-mattresses.

The laws, teachings, demands and prescriptions of the Church are not threats to our flourishing. On the contrary, they are the very restrictions that make meaningful action possible. They are the banks that ensure that the river is actually going somewhere. Accordingly, they ought to be embraced as the condition for the possibility of an authentic humanism."

I invite you to consider joining the "river" of over 50,000 pro-life witnesses who will flow through San Francisco in the 14<sup>th</sup> Annual West Coast Walk for Life on January 27. Or, be part of the firm bank for the river by your steadfast prayer support and work for the protection of the God-given human dignity of every human being from the moment of conception, through the adventure of earthly life, possible final purification in purgatory, to the heavenly harbor of perfect peace, love and justice for all.

## RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

**La paz fluye como un Río.** Aquí hay algo de reflexión del Obispo Robert Barron. "John Henry Newman dijo que lo que le da el empuje y energía a un río es precisamente la firmeza de sus bancos. Si uno derribara esos bancos, el río se extendería de inmediato a un lago perezoso, sereno quizás, pero carente de dirección.

Nuestras vidas morales y espirituales son algo así como un río: siempre que estén delimitadas por límites claros y valores objetivos, seguirán siendo intencionales y fortalecidos. En nombre de la libertad y la autoexpresión, nuestra cultura está derribando frenéticamente cada restricción imaginable, y el resultado predecible es que el río se está ensanchando en ese lago perezoso de subjetivismo e indiferencia. Podríamos ser ligeramente tolerantes unos con otros, pero carecemos de un propósito común. Ya no somos aventureros en el río rápido; más bien somos individuos, flotando lánguidamente en colchones de aire separados.

Las leyes, enseñanzas, demandas y prescripciones de la Iglesia no son amenazas para nuestro florecimiento. Por el contrario, son las mismas restricciones que hacen posible una acción significativa. Son los bancos que se aseguran de que el río llegue a algún lugar. En consecuencia, deben ser aceptados como la condición para la posibilidad de un auténtico humanismo."

Los invito a que consideren unirse al "río" de más de 50,000 testigos pro vida que pasarán por San Francisco en la XIV Caminata Anual por la Vida de la Costa Oeste el 27 de Enero. O sean parte del firme banco del río por su firmeza del apoyo a la oración y trabajo para la protección de la dignidad humana de cada ser humano desde el momento de la concepción, a través de la aventura de la vida terrenal, posible purificación final en el purgatorio, hasta el puerto celestial de la paz perfecta, amor y justicia para todos.
