**PASTOR'S CORNER**

**Spring is on the way.** Lent will begin on February 14 this year. Lent is meant to be a Spring time, that is, a new-growth-time for our spiritual lives. On the first Sunday of Lent, our parish will give out the book called, **Rediscover Jesus**, by Matthew Kelly, to 1,000 families, in an effort to promote new growth. There are forty meditations in the book to help families on their Lenten journey to the New Life of Easter. Here is a short excerpt from the book: "In every age there is much talk about the state of the world, and our times are no different. The world is a mess. We experience this mess in a hundred ways every day. There is a lot of talk about changing the world, but even the idea of changing the world has become cliché. Most people today don't actually believe the world can be changed. But it can. How? The change will not come from governments. They have their role, but you cannot legislate goodness, virtue and grace filled habits. These things come only from a heart open to God. The change will not come from the economy and big business. They also have their role, but there is no evidence that more money or a better standard of living leads to a better world in the ways that matter most. The change will not come from science, for its role is primarily a passive one of observation.

There is no group in a better position to change the world than Christians. In fact, I think it can be argued that if Christians don't change the world, the world will not change.

So how will we change the world? The answer is simple but not easy.

We will change the world simply by behaving like Christians. There are two billion Christians on the planet – anything we do together will have enormous influence. If Christians simply behaved as Christians, the world would be a different place in a matter of weeks.

But we have all failed to bring the message we receive at church on Sunday into every corner of our lives and society. And when we fail to live as we have been powerfully invited to live by Jesus in the Gospels, the incredible joy of God begins to leak from our lives." (pp. 136-137).

### PLEASE REGISTER

Why is important that we register at St. Joachim & St. Anne? Isn't it good enough that we go to Mass? Why should we bother to use the envelope system?

Registration is the official way we join a parish community. Many people think that because they attend St. Joachim's & St. Anne's they automatically belong. At times young adults who have moved away for years think they are still signed up under their parent's registration. But membership requires signing up, formally enrolling yourself with St. Joachim's & St. Anne's. Registration is commitment to a community, a way to be included in the religious, social, and ministerial activities of St. Joachim's & St. Anne's. Your registration affects St. Joachim's & St. Anne's in many ways. Census numbers can determine how many priests are assigned to a church, what benefits and obligations the community has to the diocese, and how Masses, confessions and devotions are planned and scheduled.

### REGISTRATION SHOWS YOU BELONG

It is also necessary for certain benefits, like scheduling sacraments, obtaining sponsor certificates, and getting donation statements for taxes. Registering at St. Joachim's & St. Anne's are a statement of faith and confidence in the life and work of our parish.

The expense of the envelope systems is cost effective. Using the envelope systems is a way that St. Joachim's & St. Anne's can verify your participation in weekly Mass. If you are receiving envelopes, but not using them, please consider doing this.

## RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

**La primavera está en camino.** La Cuaresma comenzará el 14 de Febrero este año. La Cuaresma está destinada a ser un tiempo de primavera, es decir, un nuevo tiempo de crecimiento para nuestras vidas espirituales. El primer domingo de Cuaresma, nuestra parroquia entregará el libro llamado **Vuelve a Descubrir a Jesús**, por Matthew Kelly, a 1,000 familias, en un esfuerzo de promover un nuevo crecimiento. Hay cuarenta meditaciones en el libro para ayudar a las familias en su viaje Cuaresmal a la Nueva Vida de Pascua. Aquí hay un breve extracto del libro:

"Se habla mucho de cambiar el mundo, pero hasta la idea de cambiar el mundo se ha convertido en un lugar común. Hoy día la mayoría de las personas no creen que el mundo puede cambiar realmente. Pero sí puede.

¿Cómo? El cambio no viene de gobiernos. Tienen su papel, pero no se puede legislar la bondad, la virtud, y la moralidad. Estas cosas solamente vienen de un corazón abierto a Dios. El cambio no vendrá de la economía ni de los grandes negocios. Estos también tienen su papel, pero no hay evidencia de que más dinero o un estándar de vida mejor lleve a un mundo mejor de las maneras que más importan. El cambio no vendrá de la ciencia, porque su papel es principalmente un papel pasivo de observación.

No hay un grupo de personas en una posición mejor para cambiar el mundo que los cristianos. De hecho, creo que puede ser argumentado que, si los cristianos no cambian el mundo, el mundo no cambiará.

Así que, ¿cómo hemos de cambiar el mundo? La respuesta es simple, pero no fácil.

Cambiamos el mundo simplemente comportándonos como cristianos. Hay dos billones de cristianos en el planeta – cualquier cosa que hagamos juntos tendrá una influencia enorme. Si los cristianos simplemente nos comportamos como cristianos, el mundo sería un lugar diferente en unas semanas.

Pero todos hemos fallado en llevar el mensaje que recibimos en la iglesia el Domingo a todos los rincones de nuestra vida y de nuestra sociedad. Y cuando no vivimos como hemos sido poderosamente invitados a vivir por Jesús en los Evangelios, la alegría increíble que Dios nos da comienza a salirse de nuestra vida." (pg. 135-136)
