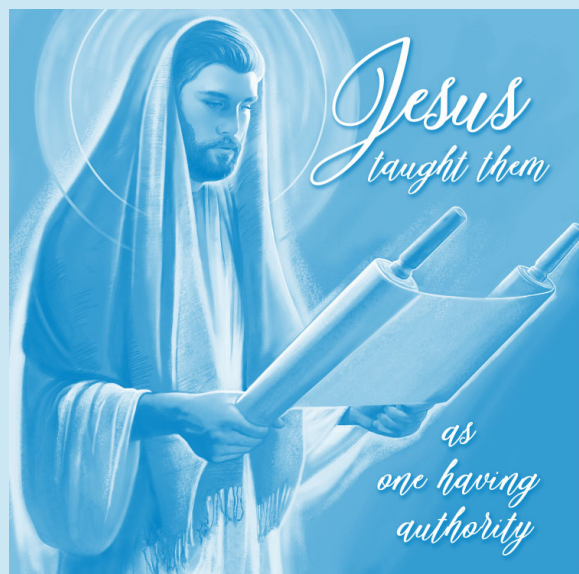
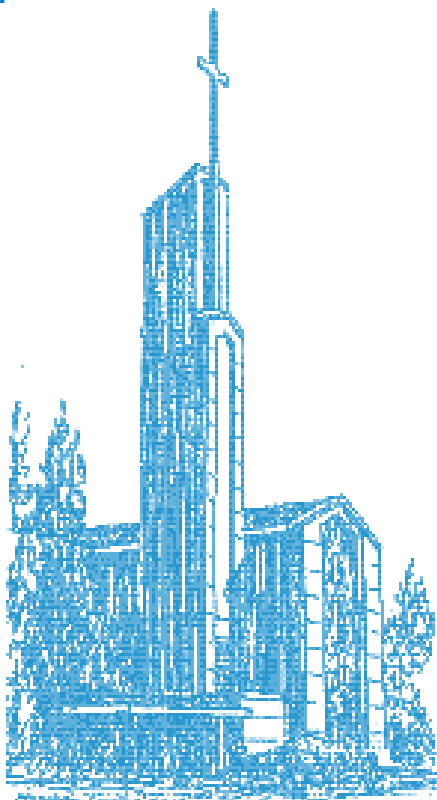

PASTOR'S CORNER

RADICAL MERCY. Fr. Rocky of Relevant Catholic Radio (1250 AM in Madera) invites us to participate in a special work of mercy to end abortion in our nation and in the world: **Let us pray 100 million "Memorares!"** one per waking hour, for all of 2018. "Prayer is powerful; and prayer through our Blessed Mother is even more powerful." *"Remember O most Blessed Virgin Mary, that never was it known, that anyone who fled to your protection, implored your help, or, sought your intercession, was left unaided. Inspired by this confidence, I fly unto you, O virgin of virgins, my mother. To you I come. Before you I stand, sinful and sorrowful. O Mother of the Word Incarnate, despise not my petitions, but in your mercy, hear and answer them, Amen.*

Through the power of intercessory prayer and compassionate witness of merciful love, not only have many babies been saved, and many mothers and families been spared the anguish of abortion, but hundreds of abortion workers have transitioned out of the abortion industry with the help of "And Then There Were None," a ministry founded by Abbie Johnson, a former manager of a Texas Planned Parenthood clinic, and now a Catholic convert. In her book, Unplanned, Johnson shares this incident: "O my word!" I heard a co-worker gasp. "What is it?" I asked her. "A nun. There is a nun in full habit standing in the driveway." ...After a 'client' left the clinic, clearly having gone through with an abortion, Sister Marie Bernadette fell to her knees and wept with such grief ... that I couldn't help but think to myself, she feels something far deeper than I ever will...this grief at knowing that client had an abortion. ...I tried to shake it off but couldn't get past the fact that a nun was grieving over what was happening inside my clinic. ...The truth was, the sister's simple, prayerful presence bothered most of us, Catholic, ex-Catholic, Protestant, and un-churched alike, as she somehow represented our consciences."

"We want to save babies, but ... it's a lot bigger than that. It's about saving families, it's about saving that woman, it's about saving the eternal souls of these people. It should be about mercy, at the forefront, all the time. ... We come together to proclaim that being truly pro-woman means embracing life, not destroying it."

Let us remember to begin praying our Memorares.

En su libro, Unplanned, Johnson comparte este incidente: "*¡Oh no! Escuché a un compañero de trabajo jadear. '¿Qué sucede?'. Le pregunté. 'Una monja. Hay una monja en hábito en la entrada.' ... Después de que un 'cliente' salió de la clínica, claramente después de un aborto, la hermana Marie Bernadette cayó de rodillas y lloró con tanto dolor ... que no pude evitarlo, y pensé entre mí, ella siente algo mucho más profundo de lo que yo jamás sentiré ... este dolor al saber que el cliente abortó. ... Traté de olvidarlo, pero no pude pasar el hecho de que una monja estaba afligida por lo que estaba sucediendo dentro de mi clínica. ... La verdad era que la presencia sencilla y orante de la hermana nos molestaba igualmente a la mayoría de nosotros, católicos, ex católicos, protestantes y no cristianos, ya que de alguna manera representaba nuestras conciencias.*"

"Queremos salvar bebés, pero ... es mucho más grande que eso. Se trata de salvar familias, se trata de salvar a esa mujer, se trata de salvar las almas eternas de estas personas. Debe ser sobre misericordia, a la vanguardia, todo el tiempo. ... Nos unimos para proclamar que ser verdaderamente pro mujer significa abrazar la vida, no destruirla."
