PASTOR'S CORNER

(Part 2) FROM ONE NATION UNDER GOD TO A NATION DIVIDED UNDER RELATIVISM. Last week I presented famous statements that reflected the world-view of the signers of the Declaration of Independence and the framers of the Constitution and Bill of Rights of the USA. This Judeo-Christian view of reality with its recognition of unalienable rights endowed on every human being by the Creator, and of objective and universal truths accessible to human reason, has been a foundation for unity and mutual respect for people living in the USA for 242 + years. However, since the beginning of what is called the sexual revolution (1960), An accelerated shift has been taking place in the world-view of many members of society. Among scholars, the new world-view, is called "post-modern relativism." Others call it "secular humanism." Here is a short explanation of what that means: ***"At the heart of liberty is the right to define one's own concept of existence, of meaning, of the universe, and the mystery of human life"*** (from a 1992 Supreme Court Decision, Planned Parenthood vs. Casey, that struck down restrictions on abortion). ***"This passage reflects the individualism and skepticism that leads to relativism. It suggests that there is no meaning to reality that all must discover and live by; rather it states that we are to be free to define – not to discover, but to define – the meaning of existence"*** (The Right To Privacy, p.52, by Janet E. Smith). In spite of its fancy title, post-modern relativism is not new. It goes all the way back to ORIGINAL SIN. It amounts to the human creature wanting to determine for himself or herself what is good and what is evil without trust in or reference to the will of the Creator. In 1973 a majority of Supreme Court Justices decided to put the so called "privacy rights" of individual women above the unalienable right to life of children in the womb. A great majority in our society have decided to place their "right" to immediate gratification through sexual pleasure over and above the God-given meaning of sexuality, marriage and family. This has led to many broken marriages and families and to the de-Christianization of society. In short, it is sin that divides us and sin that causes all the misery in our world. What then is God calling and enabling us to do to help foster the movement from **A NATION DIVIDED UNDER RELATIVISM TO ONE NATION UNDER GOD?** Stay tuned.

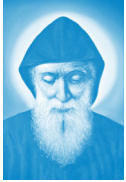

RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

(SEGUNDA PARTE) DE UNA NACIÓN BAJO DIOS A UNA NACIÓN DIVIDIDA BAJO RELATIVISMO. La semana pasada presenté declaraciones famosas que reflejaban la visión del mundo de los firmantes de la Declaración de Independencia y los redactores de la Constitución y la Carta de Derechos de los EE. UU. Esta visión judeocristiana de la realidad con su reconocimiento de los derechos inalienables que el Creador otorga a cada ser humano, y de las verdades objetivas y universales accesibles a la razón humana, ha sido la base de la unidad y el respeto mutuo para las personas que viven en los Estados Unidos por 242 años y más. Sin embargo, desde el comienzo de lo que se llama la revolución sexual (1960), se ha producido un cambio acelerado en la visión del mundo de muchos miembros de la sociedad. Entre los estudiosos, la nueva visión del mundo se llama "relativismo posmoderno". Otros lo llaman "humanismo secular". Aquí hay una breve explicación de lo que eso significa: *"En el corazón de la libertad está el derecho a definir el propio concepto de existencia, de significado, del universo y el misterio de la vida humana"* (de una Decisión del Tribunal Supremo de 1992, Planned Parenthood vs. Casey, que anuló las restricciones al aborto). *"Este pasaje refleja el individualismo y el escepticismo que conduce al relativismo. Sugiere que no hay ningún significado para la realidad que todos deben descubrir y vivir; sino que establece que debemos ser libres de definir, no de descubrir, sino de definir, el significado de la existencia."* (The Right To Privacy, p.52, por Janet E. Smith). A pesar de su título elegante, el relativismo posmoderno no es nuevo. Se remonta al PECADO ORIGINAL. Equivale a la criatura humana que quiere determinar por sí misma lo que es bueno y lo que es malo sin confianza o referencia a la voluntad del Creador. En 1973, la mayoría de los jueces de la Corte Suprema decidieron poner los llamados "derechos de privacidad" de las mujeres individuales por encima del derecho inalienable a la vida de los niños en el vientre. Una gran mayoría en nuestra sociedad ha decidido colocar su "derecho" a la gratificación inmediata a través del placer sexual más allá del significado dado por Dios de la sexualidad, el matrimonio y la familia. Esto ha llevado a muchos matrimonios y familias rotas y a la descristianización de la sociedad. En resumen, es el pecado el que nos divide y el pecado el que causa toda la miseria en nuestro mundo. ¿Qué es lo que Dios está llamando y capacitándonos para ayudar a fomentar el movimiento de UNA NACIÓN DIVIDIDA BAJO RELATIVISMO A UNA NACIÓN BAJO DIOS? Manténganse al tanto.
