QUOTABLE QUOTES. I was going through my "Gems of Wisdom" file and I came across this quote that a priest friend had published in his bulletin years ago. "Seems there was a sincere man who wanted to live a holy life. So, he went to his Rabbi to seek his advice. The Rabbi congratulated him on his ambition, then asked, "How have you been faring so far?" "Quite well, I think," the man replied. "When you say, 'well,' 'what do you mean?" the Rabbi asked. "I haven't broken any of the commandments," the man replied. "I haven't taken the Lord's name in vain. I haven't profaned the Sabbath. I haven't dishonored my father and mother. I haven't killed anyone. I haven't been unfaithful to my wife. I haven't lied to anyone. And I haven't coveted my neighbor's wife or goods." "I see," said the Rabbi, "you haven't broken any of the commandments." "That's right," the man replied with pride.
