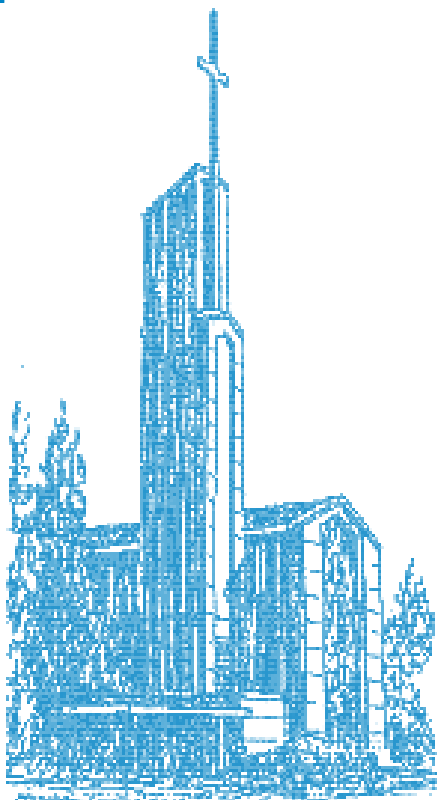

**PASTOR'S CORNER**

**(Part 1) ONE NATION UNDER GOD.** "We hold these truths to be self-evident; that all men are created equal and are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable rights; among these are life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness" (Declaration of Independence). This foundational statement, penned by Thomas Jefferson, was signed by the founding fathers to justify a revolutionary war to overthrow the tyranny of the British and establish the United States of America, "One Nation under God with Liberty and Justice for all" (Pledge of Allegiance) in "the Land of the Free and the Home of the Brave" (National Anthem). The USA, with its Declaration of Independence, Constitution and Bill of Rights, became a beacon of light to the "huddled masses yearning to breathe free" (inscription in Statue of Liberty). Over nearly 250 years, the USA, a nation predominantly of immigrants from many other nations, has made progress in living up to its ideals by eliminating the scourge of slavery (1865), recognizing the equal dignity of women in the right to vote (1920), protecting the rights of workers, children, the poor and minorities through an ongoing civil rights movement. Many brave Americans have shed their blood (Civil War, WWI, WWII, Korea, Viet Nam, Iraq, Afghanistan, etc.) in an effort to defeat unjust aggression against our nation and its allies. "IN GOD WE TRUST" is printed on our money. "E PLURIBUS UNUM" – OUT OF MANY, ONE - is the nation's motto. Let's be clear, that whatever imperfect unity our nation has enjoyed for over 200 years, was based on a once great majority world-view: a view that believed in "self-evident truths," "inalienable rights" that are endowed by the Divine Creator, and reverence for objective and universal truths accessible to human reason (Natural Law). Next week I will try to unmask the root cause behind the tremendous upsurge in divisiveness we are experiencing in our lives, our families, our politics, our nation and our world. ## RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

**(Primera Parte) UNA NACIÓN BAJO DIOS.** “Sostenemos que estas verdades son evidentes por sí mismas; que todos los hombres son creados iguales y están dotados por su Creador de ciertos derechos inalienables; entre ellos está la vida, la libertad y la búsqueda de la felicidad.” (Declaración de Independencia). Esta declaración fundamental, escrita por Thomas Jefferson, fué firmada por los padres fundadores para justificar una guerra revolucionaria para derrocar la tiranía de los británicos y establecer los Estados Unidos de América, “Una nación bajo Dios con libertad y justicia para todos” (Juramento de Lealtad) en “La Tierra de los Libres y el Hogar de los Valientes” (Himno Nacional). Estados Unidos, con su Declaración de Independencia, Constitución y Carta de Derechos, se convirtió en un faro de luz para las “masas acurrucadas que anhelan respirar libremente” (inscripción en la Estatua de la Libertad). Durante casi 250 años, EE. UU., una nación predominantemente de inmigrantes de muchas otras naciones, ha progresado en la realización de sus ideales al eliminar el flagelo de la esclavitud (1865), reconociendo la igual dignidad de las mujeres en el derecho al voto (1920), proteger los derechos de los trabajadores, los niños, los pobres y las minorías a través de un movimiento en curso de derechos civiles. Muchos estadounidenses valientes han derramado su sangre (Guerra Civil, Primera Guerra Mundial, Segunda Guerra Mundial, Corea, Vietnam, Irak, Afganistán, etc.) en un esfuerzo por vencer la injusta agresión contra nuestra nación y sus aliados. “EN DIOS CONFIAMOS” está impreso en nuestro dinero. “E PLURIBUS UNUM” - DE MUCHOS, UNO - es el lema de la nación. Seamos claros, que cualquiera que sea la unidad imperfecta que nuestra nación haya disfrutado durante más de 200 años, se basó en una vez una gran visión del mundo: una visión que creía en “verdades evidentes por sí mismas”, “derechos inalienables” que están dotados por el Divino Creador y reverencia por verdades objetivas y universales accesibles a la razón humana (Ley Natural). La próxima semana intentaré desenmascarar la causa raíz detrás del tremendo aumento en la división que estamos experimentando en nuestras vidas, nuestras familias, nuestra política, nuestra nación y nuestro mundo.
