PASTOR'S CORNER

(Part 2) HUMANAЕ VITAE - ON HUMAN LIFE. In this Encyclical Blessed Paul VI reaffirmed the Church's constant teaching that to deliberately sterilize the marriage act is an intrinsic evil, even if one's motive is to achieve a moral good, such as guarding the health of the mother, or, insuring the welfare of the family. In 1968 the majority opinion in secular society, among most Protestants and, even among most U. S. and European Catholic theologians, was that the responsible use of the new contraceptive technologies would be good for marriage; good because they could remove the fear of unwanted pregnancies while promoting the good of the intimate union of the couple. Many Catholics were told by a significant portion of Catholic clergy to "follow their conscience" on this "controversial" issue. Blessed Paul VI warned that artificial birth control would not be good for marriage or society at large. He wrote, "*how wide and easy a road would thus be opened up toward conjugal infidelity and the general lowering of morality. ... the man may lose respect for the woman to the point of considering her as a mere instrument of selfish enjoyment*" (HV 17). Now that we have had 50-plus-years of the sexual revolution, which in effect, substituted a self-indulgent focus on sexual pleasure (the sin of lust) for a marriage act designed by God to express self-gift through life-giving love, there is an abundance of evidence to assess who is right. "U.S. pornography revenue is larger than all combined revenues of all professional football, baseball and basketball franchises" (2004 IFR research). "For every 10 men in church, 5 are struggling with pornography" (*The Call to Biblical Manhood. July 6, 2004*). The average rate of divorce in U.S. marriages is close to 50%. The rate of divorce for married couples using NFP to plan their families is less than 2%. "40.7% of all reported births in the U.S. were out-of-wedlock" (2012 CDC report). In 1960 the rate was 3%. "85% of youths in prisons grew up in a fatherless home" (Texas Dept. of Corrections 1992). Since 1973 there have been close to 60 million legal surgical abortions in the USA alone. Is there a strong connection between the "safe-sex contraceptive mentality" and the astronomical number of deaths by abortion? I will explore this question next week.

RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

(PARTE 2) HUMANAЕ VITAE – SOBRE LA VIDA HUMANA.

En esta Encíclica, el Beato Pablo VI reafirmó la constante enseñanza de la iglesia que; de deliberadamente esterilizar que el acto matrimonial es un mal intrínseco, incluso si uno de los motivos es lograr un bien moral, tal como vigilar la salud de la madre, o, asegurar el bienestar de la familia. En 1968 la opinión mayoritaria en la sociedad secular, entre la mayoría de los protestantes e, incluso entre la mayoría de los teólogos católicos europeos y estadounidenses, fue que el uso responsable de las nuevas tecnologías anticonceptivas serían buenas para el matrimonio; buenas porque podrían eliminar el miedo a los embarazos no deseados, mientras que se promueva el bien de la Unión íntima de la pareja. Una porción significativa del clero católico dijo a muchos católicos que "siguieran su conciencia" en este "polémico" asunto. El Beato Pablo VI advirtió que el control de la natalidad artificial no sería bueno para el matrimonio o la sociedad en general. Él escribió: "¿Qué tan amplio y fácil se abriría un camino hacia la infidelidad conyugal y la reducción general de la moralidad. ... el hombre puede perder el respeto por la mujer hasta el punto de considerarla como un mero instrumento de gozo egoísta "(HV 17). Ahora que hemos tenido mas-de-50-años de la revolución sexual, que en efecto, sustituyó un enfoque auto-indulgente en el placer sexual (el pecado de la lujuria) para un acto de matrimonio diseñado por Dios para expresar el auto-regalo a través del amor que da la vida, hay una abundancia de evidencia para evaluar quién tiene razón. "los ingresos por pornografía en Estados Unidos son más grandes que todos los ingresos combinados de todas las franquicias profesionales de fútbol, béisbol y baloncesto" (2004 IFR Research). "Por cada 10 hombres en la iglesia, 5 están luchando con la pornografía" (El Llamado a la Masculinidad Bíblica. 6 de julio de 2004). La tasa promedio de divorcio en los matrimonios estadounidenses es cercana al 50%. La tasa de divorcio para las parejas casadas que utilizan NFP para planificar sus familias es inferior al 2%. "El 40.7% de todos los nacimientos registrados en los Estados Unidos fueron fuera del matrimonio" (2012 CDC Report). En 1960 la tasa fué del 3%. "El 85% de los jóvenes en las prisiones crecieron en una casa paterna" (Departamento de correcciones de Texas 1992). Desde 1973 ha habido cerca de 60 millones de abortos quirúrgicos legales en los Estados Unidos solamente. ¿existe una fuerte conexión entre la "mentalidad anticonceptiva del sexo seguro" y el número astronómico de muertes por aborto? Voy a explorar esta pregunta la próxima semana.
