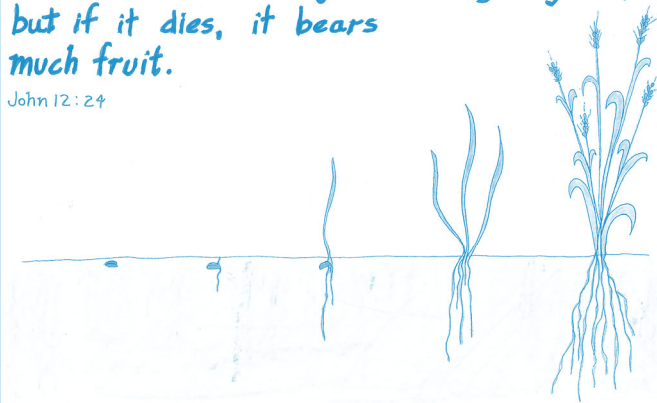

PASTOR'S CORNER

“Be in good spirits under the fatherly mantle of Saint Joseph, a place of safest refuge in trials and tribulations.” (St. Joseph Marelló.) In this month of Saint Joseph, as we conclude our Novena and prepare to celebrate the Solemnity of Saint Joseph on Monday, March 19, let us contemplate this exhortation of St. John Paul II.

“Joseph did as the angel of the Lord commanded him and took his wife” (cf. Mt. 1:24). Inspired by the Gospel, the Fathers of the Church from the earliest centuries stressed that just as Saint Joseph took loving care of Mary and gladly dedicated himself to Jesus Christ’s upbringing, he likewise watches over and protects Christ’s Mystical Body, that is, the Church, of which the Virgin Mary is the exemplar and model. ... I wish to offer for your consideration, dear brothers and sisters, some reflections concerning him “to whose custody God entrusted his most precious treasures.” I gladly fulfill this pastoral duty so that all may grow in devotion to the Patron of the Universal Church and in love for [Jesus and Mary] whom he served in such an exemplary manner. In this way the whole Christian people not only will turn to Saint Joseph with greater fervor and invoke his patronage with trust, but always will keep before their eyes his humble, mature way of serving and of “taking part” in the plan of salvation (Guardian of the Redeemer 1).

At the beginning of our Council and Board meetings, we always invoke St. Joseph’s intercession for the guidance of our parish community. We pray at the beginning of each Mass that St. Joseph will be the special patron for the planning, financing and building of our much-needed new church. Let us now celebrate with great gratitude Saint Joseph’s beneficial patronage on Monday, March 19 (Masses at 7 am, 8 am and 7 pm (bilingual)).
