PASTOR'S CORNER

A NEW PENTECOST! In his Encyclical letter on Evangelization, Blessed Paul VI stated that people will listen to witnesses much more than to teachers. On May 3, I attended the Mayor's Prayer Breakfast along with about 500 others at Hatfield Hall. Mayor Andy Medellin said that he had decided to share from the heart rather than prepare a speech. He confided that his greatest fear was that he would fail to hear God's word in prayer, and thus, fail to fulfill God's plan for his service to the people of Madera. He mentioned the ordeal he is going through of late, and his gratitude to God and to those who have prayed for him. He concluded his sharing by stating that he had asked God to give him the virtues of courage, strength and leadership. As he listened for God's response, he sensed the small, still prompting of the Holy Spirit forming this thought in his mind: *"I am giving you courage to forgive; I am giving you strength to forgive; and I am giving you leadership to forgive."* Andy, thank you for being a witness. My hope is that your witness will open our hearts to the truth of this teaching: *"I urge you to live in a manner worthy of the call you have received ... striving to preserve the unity of the spirit through the bond of peace"* (Eph. 4:3). We live in the "end times," the age of the Holy Spirit, the Church and the Sacraments. Scripture tells us that as the end nears, our world will be distressed more and more by turmoil and division. Because of Pentecost a great power is being poured into the hearts of Jesus' disciples – the power of Merciful Love. Merciful Love is another name for the Holy Spirit. Jesus prayed at the Last Supper, *"I have given them the glory you gave me, so that they may be one, as we are one, I in them and you in me, that they may be brought to perfection as one, that the world may know that you sent me, and that you loved them even as you loved me"* (John 17:22-23). "Glory" is another name for the Holy Spirit. The Gift of the Spirit enables us to enter into intimate Communion with the Father and the Son and one another. The Holy Spirit enables us to hate the sin, but still love the sinner, including ourselves. The Holy Spirit enables us to hate the injustice, the offense, the harm done, and still love even an enemy. Instead of mis-directing our anger at our fellow human beings, the Holy Spirit will enable us to will the good for even our worst enemy in the same way that Jesus willed the eternal salvation and happiness of every human being as he hung upon the cross: *"Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do"* (Luke 23:34).

RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

¡UN NUEVO PENTECOSTÉS! En su carta Encíclica sobre Evangelización, el Beato Pablo VI declaró que las personas escucharán a los testigos mucho más que a los maestros. El 3 de Mayo, asistí al Desayuno de Oración del Alcalde junto con otras 500 personas en Salón Hatfield. El alcalde Andy Medellín dijo que había decidido compartir del corazón en lugar de preparar un discurso. Él nos confió que su mayor temor era fracasar en no escuchar la palabra de Dios en oración, y, por lo tanto, no cumpliría el plan de Dios para su servicio a la gente de Madera. Mencionó la dura experiencia que atraviesa últimamente, y su gratitud a Dios y a aquellos que han orado por él. Concluyó su compartimiento diciendo que le había pedido a Dios que le diera las virtudes de la valentía, la fuerza y el liderazgo. Mientras escuchaba la respuesta de Dios, sintió la pequeña e inmóvil indicación del Espíritu Santo formando este pensamiento en su mente: *“Te estoy dando la valentía para perdonar; te estoy dando fuerza para perdonar; y te estoy dando liderazgo para perdonar.”* Andy, gracias por ser un testigo. Mi esperanza es que tu testimonio abra nuestros corazones a la verdad de esta enseñanza: *“Les exhorto, pues, a que se muestren dignos de la vocación que han recibido ... mantengan entre ustedes lazos de paz y permanezcan unidos en el mismo espíritu.”* (Efesios 4:1, 3). Vivimos en los “últimos tiempos”, la época del Espíritu Santo, la Iglesia y los Sacramentos. La Escritura nos dice que a medida que se acerca el fin, nuestro mundo se angustiará cada vez más por el disturbio y la división. Debido a Pentecostés, un gran poder se está derramando en los corazones de los discípulos de Jesús: el poder del Amor Misericordioso. El Amor Misericordioso es otro nombre para el Espíritu Santo. Jesús oró en la Última Cena: *“Yo les he dado la Gloria que tú me diste, para que sean uno como nosotros somos uno: yo en ellos y tú en mí. Así alcanzarán la perfección en la unidad, y el mundo conocerá que tú me has enviado y que yo los he amado a ellos como tú me amas a mí.”* (Juan 17:22-23). “Gloria” es otro nombre para el Espíritu Santo. El don del Espíritu nos permite entrar en una comunión íntima con el Padre y el Hijo y entre nosotros. El Espíritu Santo nos permite odiar el pecado, pero aun así amar al pecador, incluyéndonos a nosotros mismos. El Espíritu Santo nos permite odiar la injusticia, la ofensa, el daño hecho, y aún amar incluso a un enemigo. En lugar de desviar nuestra ira hacia nuestros semejantes, el Espíritu Santo nos permitirá desear incluso a nuestro peor enemigo de la misma manera en que Jesús deseó la salvación eterna y la felicidad de cada ser humano mientras colgaba de la cruz: *“Padre, perdónalos, porque no saben lo que hacen.”* (Lucas 23:34).
