PASTOR'S CORNER

MOST HOLY TRINITY: This is the Mystery of Mysteries. It was revealed to humanity in the fullness of time when “*God so loved the world that he gave his only Son*” (John 3:16) through the Mystery of the Incarnation when the eternal “*Word became flesh and dwelt among us, full of grace and truth*” (John 1:14). Jesus, true God and true man, tells us, “*I have much more to tell you, but you cannot bear it now. But when he comes, the Spirit of truth, he will guide you to all truth. ... He will glorify me, because he will take from what is mine and declare it to you. Everything that the Father has is mine; for this reason I told you that he will take from what is mine and declare it to you*” (John 16:12-15). Without using the word, “Trinity,” Sacred Scripture has made the amazing three person nature of God evident to us. **How can there be three divine persons and still only one God?** This question boggles our finite creaturely minds. On the surface, Judaism and Islam are more attractive to human reason because they deny the Mystery of the Trinity and stick with the partial truth that there is only ONE GOD. So, how are we to justify our attraction to the Mystery of the Trinity? The French Philosopher, Blaise Pascal, put it this way, “*The heart has reasons that reason does not know.*” The key to penetrating the mystery of the Trinity with our human reason is to fathom the great truth that GOD has revealed himself in his essence as LOVE, pure and simple. “*God is love*” (1 John 4:8). **Three-Persons-in-One-God may challenge our logical reasoning, but, it rings true to the human heart.** In human experience and understanding authentic love implies a minimum of two persons: a giver and a receiver. Love can be mutual and form a communion of persons. **God has revealed himself as an eternal communion of mutual Self-Gift in three Persons.** By free grace God has chosen to create human beings in his image and likeness, the image and likeness of love. The visible icon of human marriage/family helps us encounter the invisible reality of God as an Eternal Communion of Life and Love. God has chosen to bring about an intimate communion between divinity and humanity through the Incarnation of his Only Begotten Son, Jesus. Jesus is revealed as the Divine Bridegroom of the human race and every human heart. He offers eternal life and holy communion to each and every human being who dares to use their freedom to turn away from sin and accept the grace and truth offered to us by God, the **MOST HOLY TRINITY.**

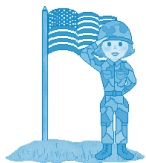

RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

LA SANTÍSIMA TRINIDAD: Este es el Misterio de los Misterios. Fué revelado a la humanidad en la plenitud del tiempo cuando “*Dios tanto amo al mundo que dio a su único Hijo*” (Juan 3:16) por medio del Misterio de la Encarnación cuando el eterno “*La Palabra se hizo carne*” (Juan 1:14) Jesús, verdadero Dios y verdadero hombre, nos dice, “*Aún tengo muchas cosas que decirles, pero es demasiado para ustedes por ahora. Y cuando venga él, el Espíritu de la Verdad, los guiará en todos los caminos de la verdad... El tomará de lo mío para revelárselo a ustedes, y yo seré glorificado por él. Todo lo que tiene el Padre es mío. Por eso les he dicho que tomará de lo mío para revelárselo a ustedes.*” (Juan 16:12-15) Sin usar la palabra “Trinidad”, la Sagrada Escritura ha hecho evidente la asombrosa naturaleza de las tres personas de Dios. **¿Cómo puede haber tres personas divinas y aún un solo Dios?** Esta pregunta aturde nuestras mentes criaturas finitas. En la superficie, el Judaísmo y el Islam son más atractivos para la razón humana porque niegan el Misterio de la Trinidad y se quedan con la verdad parcial de que solo hay UN DIOS. Entonces, ¿cómo vamos a justificar nuestra atracción por el Misterio de la Trinidad? El filósofo francés, Blaise Pascal, lo expresó de esta manera: “*El corazón tiene razones que la razón no sabe.*” La clave para penetrar en el misterio de la Trinidad con nuestra razón humana es comprender la gran verdad que DIOS se ha revelado en su esencia como AMOR, puro y simple. “*Dios es amor*” (1 Juan 4:8). **Tres-Personas-en-Un-Dios puede desafiar nuestro razonamiento lógico, pero suena fiel al corazón humano.** En la experiencia humana y la comprensión del amor auténtico implica un mínimo de dos personas: un dador y un receptor. El amor puede ser mutuo y formar una comunión de personas. **Dios se ha revelado a sí mismo como una comunión eterna de auto-regalo mutuo en tres personas.** Por la gracia gratuita Dios ha elegido crear seres humanos a su imagen y semejanza, la imagen y semejanza del amor. El icono visible del matrimonio/familia humana nos ayuda a encontrar la realidad invisible de Dios como una Comunión Eterna de Vida y Amor. Dios ha elegido provocar una comunión íntima entre la divinidad y la humanidad a través de la Encarnación de su Hijo Unigénito, Jesús. Jesús se revela como el Esposo Divino de la raza humana y cada corazón humano. Él ofrece la vida eterna y la comunión sagrada a todos y cada uno de los seres humanos que se atreven a usar su libertad para alejarse del pecado y aceptar la gracia y la verdad que Dios nos ofrece, **LA SANTÍSIMA TRINIDAD.**
