PASTOR'S CORNER

THANKSGIVING. It's time to look back on the year of our Lord, 2018, and give thanks to God for some of the significant blessings that benefit our whole parish. We are grateful for the steady donations to our Offertory and 2nd collections throughout the year. This past July, after nearly 10 years of once-a-month second collections, **we paid off our \$690,000.00 assessment for the Diocese of Fresno "Our Faith, Our Family, Our Future" Capital Campaign.** Special thanks to Fr. Shaji and his generous committee of volunteers and donors who helped raise a record \$108,000.00 in 2017 and \$120,000.00 in 2018 through our annual Harvest Festivals. This money helped us to invest \$70,000.00 to complete **the conversion to LED lighting** of all our parking lots, church, halls, parish center, store and school buildings. This project drops our use of electricity by 18%. **We were able to invest in solar panels to provide energy for our entire school, hall, church and parish center campus.** The cost for the hardware is close to \$720,000.00. Our plan is to pay this loan off in 15 years with the money we would normally give to PG&E in monthly power bills. Side benefits are some nice shade structures and better night lighting for our parking lots. **In the following 15 years, the parish will save nearly one million dollars** as we generate our own electricity with our own hardware! Special THANKS to Deacon Alan Shearer, Principal Darlene Lopez and Business Manager Enrique Medina for over-seeing the LED – SOLAR project. We repaired the damaged roof and stucco wall on our parish hall and gymnasium. We brought our rectory office into compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) by building a concrete ramp with rails. We opened eleven storage units in the parish center for use by some of our most active ministry groups. We repaired the main rear porch entrance to our church and added ADA compliant rails. We upgraded and beautified our side-chapel, sacristy and main parking lot rest rooms. Special THANKS to Ricardo Hernandez, Luis Garcia, and Rosanne Bonilla for extra generous sharing of time, talent and treasure on the restrooms renovation project. A big THANK YOU to members of our parish and finance councils who provided leadership and oversight to everything above. **AND THANKS BE TO GOD!** Stay tuned for more **GRATITUDE** next week.
