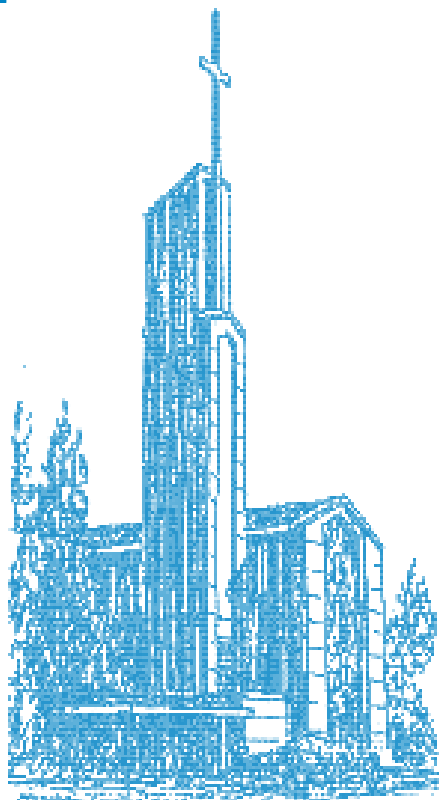

**PASTOR'S CORNER**

**PRAY THE ROSARY DAILY.** We continue to share parts of St. John Paul II's Letter on the Rosary, published on October 16, 2002 and taken from "A Simplified Version" by Rev. Msgr. Vincent M. Walsh. Key of David Publications, phone/fax 610-896-1970.

**"Revealing the Truth About Man.** Because 'the simple prayer of the Rosary marks the rhythm of life' (St. John Paul II – 1978) we can grasp the meaning of human existence. Contemplating these mysteries of Christ reveals the truth about man. 'It is only in the mystery of the Word made flesh that the mystery of man is seen in its true light.' (Second Vatican Council). Man's path is 'recapitulated' (St. Irenaeus) in the path of Christ where believers can see the image of the true man.

**Shedding Light on Man.** Christ's birth shows the sanctity of life. Nazareth shows the family according to God's plan. Listening to Jesus in his public life reveals the path into God's kingdom. Following Jesus to Calvary teaches the meaning of salvific suffering. Contemplating Jesus and Mary in glory shows the goal of every person if they are transformed by the Holy Spirit. Each mystery of the Rosary sheds light on the mystery of man.

**Bring Your Burdens.** To this encounter with Jesus, the believer brings all his problems, labors and endeavors. 'Cast your burdens on the Lord and he will sustain you.' (Psalm 55:23). While praying the Rosary we hand over our burdens to the merciful hearts of Christ and Mary. ...I warmly invite all to experience personally that the Rosary brings the 'rhythm of human life' into harmony with the 'rhythm of God's life' (a joyful communion of three Divine Persons)."
