PASTOR'S CORNER

THANKSGIVING (2). I continue our litany of thanksgiving for blessings to our Parish in the past year. Thanks to Ricardo Hernandez, there is a new tile floor in our CCD office and upgrades and repairs to our parish center restrooms. The grass lawn in our parish center courtyard has a new and upgraded drainage system. Our Youth Ministry Meeting Room has new and more ample cabinets for storage. Thanks to a very generous donor, St. Joachim School (SJS) has converted their computer lab into a class room and new bathroom for the Pre-School program. SJS can now offer a full time Pre-School Program for up to 48 children. Thanks to volunteer skilled laborers, SJS began the new school year looking cleaner with a new coat of paint on many of its pillars and walls. Our St. Agnes Chapel and Hall near Hwy 145 and Ave. 7 has been hosting the Extraordinary Migrant Program for preparation of children, adolescents and adults for Sacraments of Baptism, First Holy Communion, Confirmation and Matrimony in a program that runs from April to October. We thank God for the many catechists who help this bi-lingual program bear good fruit. New lighting and a shaded concrete patio have been added behind the St. Agnes Hall. More improvements are being planned. Some of the acreage will be leased to a local farmer for growing vines or trees instead of weeds. There will be some modest and steady income to help maintain and improve the property. We are grateful for the generous donors and volunteer skilled laborers at St. Anne's Chapel in Raymond-Knowles who have recently brought their play-ground swing set into compliance with State safety codes. Thus far I have been focusing on significant physical improvements to our parish. I conclude by noting the daily outpouring of Divine Love through our parish sponsored Corporal Work of Mercy known as **HOLY FAMILY TABLE**. Close to 90,000 meals have been served thus far in 2018. Let us all participate in this ministry by generously giving through the Thanksgiving Day and November 25 annual HFT Collections. Next week I will turn the thanksgiving spotlight on the great spiritual blessings of the past year. **THANKS BE TO GOD!**

Gracias a un donante muy generoso, la escuela St. Joachim (SSJ) ha convertido su laboratorio de computadoras en una sala de clase y un nuevo cuarto de baño para el programa pre-escolar. SSJ ahora puede ofrecer un programa de tiempo completo pre-escolar para hasta 48 niños. Gracias a voluntarios trabajadores expertos, SJS comenzó el nuevo año escolar luciendo más limpio con una nueva mano de pintura en muchos de sus pilares y paredes. Nuestra Capilla y Salón de Santa Inés cerca del Hwy 145 y Avenida 7 han estado recibiendo el Programa Extraordinario Migrante para la preparación de niños, adolescentes y adultos para Sacramentos de Bautismo, Primera Comunión, Confirmación y Matrimonio en un programa que dura de abril a octubre. Agradecemos a Dios por catequistas que ayudan en este del programa bilingüe a dar buen fruto. Nueva iluminación y un patio de concreto sombreado han sido añadidos detrás del Salón de Santa Inés. Se planean más mejoras. Algunas de las hectareas se arrendarán a un agricultor local para cultivar vides o árboles en vez de maleza. Habrá algunos ingresos modestos y constantes para ayudar a mantener y mejorar la propiedad. Estamos agradecidos por los donantes generosos y voluntarios trabajadores capacitados en la Capilla de St. Anne en Raymond-Knowles que han traído recientemente su juego de columpios del patio de juegos en la conformidad con códigos de seguridad Estatales. Hasta ahora me he centrado en mejoras físicas significativas en nuestra parroquia. Termino señalando el derramamiento diario del Amor Divino a través de nuestra parroquia patrocinado por El Trabajo Corporal de Misericordia conocida como la **MESA DE LA SAGRADA FAMILIA**. Cerca de 90.000 comidas se han servido hasta el momento en el 2018.
