**PASTOR'S CORNER**

**FIRST WORLD DAY OF THE POOR.** Find here some excerpts from Pope Francis' Letter to us all. "At the conclusion of the Jubilee of Mercy, I wanted to offer the Church a *World Day of the Poor*, so that throughout the world Christian communities can become an ever greater sign of Christ's charity for the least and those most in need. To the World Days, (World Youth Day, World Marriage Day, etc.) instituted by my Predecessors, which are already a tradition in the life of our communities, I wish to add this one, which adds to them an exquisitely evangelical fullness, that is, Jesus' preferential love for the poor. ...This Day is meant, above all, to encourage believers to react against a culture of discard and waste, and to embrace the culture of encounter. 'This poor man cried, and the Lord heard him' (Psalm 34:6). The Church has always understood the importance of this cry. We possess an outstanding testimony to this in the very first pages of the Acts of the Apostles, where Peter asks that seven men, 'full of the Spirit and of wisdom' (6:3), be chosen for the ministry of caring for the poor. This is certainly one of the first signs of the entrance of the Christian community upon the world's stage: the service of the poor."

Our Parish of St. Joachim honors with generous support the history and the ministry of the **HOLY FAMILY TABLE**. It began decades ago with the initiative of Deacon Jim Kledzik and some volunteers distributing food to hungry persons in the local parks from the trunk of a car. It has grown to seven crews, 'full of the Spirit and of wisdom,' who provide a full and wholesome meal to hundreds of hungry men, women and children, seven mornings a week, three hundred and sixty-five days a year at Griffin Hall. The seven cooking crews are supported by many volunteers, from our parish and from the wider community, young and old, who provide food serving, cleanup, fund raising, and regular donations.

Thank you for your generosity in this weekend's second collection in support of the Holy Family Table and in the Spirit of the **FIRST WORLD DAY OF THE POOR**.

**Primer Día Mundial de los Pobres.** Encuentra aquí algunos extractos de la carta del Papa Francisco a todos nosotros. "A la conclusión del Jubileo de la Misericordia, yo quería ofrecer a la iglesia *Un Día Mundial de los Pobres*, para que en todo el mundo las comunidades cristianas se conviertan en un signo cada vez mayor a la caridad de Cristo para los menos y los más necesitados. A los Días del Mundo, (Día Mundial de la Juventud, Día Mundial del Matrimonio, etc.) instituido por mis predecesores, que ya son una tradición en la vida de nuestras comunidades, deseo añadir éste, que les añade una plenitud exquisitamente evangélica, es decir, el amor preferencial de Jesús para los pobres. ... Este día se entiende, sobre todo, para animar a los creyentes a reaccionar contra una cultura de descartes y desechos, y a abrazar la cultura del encuentro. 'este pobre hombre lloró, y el Señor le oyó' (Salmo 34:6). La Iglesia siempre ha comprendido la importancia de este grito. Poseemos un testimonio excepcional de esto en las primeras páginas de los Hechos de los Apóstoles, donde Pedro pide que siete hombres, 'llenos del espíritu y de la sabiduría' (6:3), sean elegidos para el Ministerio de cuidado de los pobres. Este es sin duda uno de los primeros inicios de la entrada de la comunidad cristiana en la escena mundial: el servicio de los pobres." Nuestra parroquia de San Joaquín honra con generoso apoyo la historia y el Ministerio de la **MESA DE LA SAGRADA FAMILIA**. Comenzó hace décadas con la iniciativa del Diácono Jim Kledzik y algunos voluntarios distribuyendo alimentos a personas con hambre en los parques locales desde la cajuela de un coche.
