PASTOR'S CORNER

**Letter on the Rosary by St. Pope John Paul II
(October – 2002). Part II.**

“Chapter 1: Contemplating Christ With Mary – Mary’s Memories: Mary pondered all of Christ’s words “in her heart” (Lk.2:19 and 2:51). These memories were her “Rosary” which she recited throughout her earthly life. Even in heaven, she has maternal concern for the Church on earth. She hopes that our contemplating these mysteries will release their saving power. By reciting the Rosary, the Christian community enters into the memories and the contemplative gaze of Mary.

The Need for Contemplation: The Rosary should be an exquisitely contemplative prayer. “Without contemplation the Rosary is a body without a soul and runs the risk of becoming a mechanical repetition of formulas” (Bl. Pope Paul VI). The Rosary demands a quiet rhythm and lingering pace, as the person meditates on the mysteries so their unfathomable riches are disclosed. “The Rosary is a form of Christ-centered contemplation” (Bl. Pope Paul VI).

Mary Teaches Us: Christ is both the revealer and the one revealed. Besides learning his teaching, we must learn Him. The interior teacher is the Spirit who leads us to the full truth (John14:26;15:26;16:13). Among all creatures, Mary knows Christ most perfectly and introduces us to a profound knowledge of his mystery. ... Besides teaching us, Mary offers examples from her own “pilgrimage of faith.” While we contemplate each mystery, she encourages us to ask questions as she did. This led to her words, “Let it be done to me according to your will.” (Lk.1:38).

VETERANS DAY



Veterans Day is observed every year on November 11th. Veterans Day was originally called "Armistice Day" when President Woodrow Wilson proclaimed this day in November 1919. Armistice is when warring parties agree to stop fighting, and "Armistice Day" recognized the end of World War 1 when hostilities ceased on November 11th at 11 A.M, 1918 (11th hour, of the 11th day, of the 11th month).

On May 13th, 1938 Armistice Day was declared a legal holiday. A day to be dedicated to the cause of world peace. Originally Armistice Day only honored veterans of World War.

On November 11th, 1947 Raymond Weeks, a World War II veteran, organized a "National Veterans Day" parade in Birmingham, Alabama to recognize veterans of all wars.

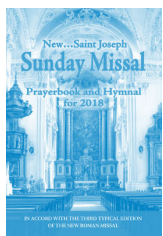
This celebration led to Congress changing Armistice Day to Veterans Day in 1954 to recognize Veterans of all U.S. wars.

Carta acerca del Rosario por el Papa San Juan Pablo II (Octubre -2002). Parte II

“Capítulo 1: Contemplando a Cristo con María - Las Memorias de María: María conservaba todas las palabras de Cristo “en su corazón” (Lc. 2:19 y 2:51). Estas memorias eran su “Rosario” el cual recitó a lo largo de toda su vida terrenal. Incluso en el cielo, ella tiene una preocupación maternal por la Iglesia en la tierra. Ella espera que nuestra contemplación de estos misterios liberen su poder de salvación. Al recitar el Rosario, la comunidad Cristiana entra en las memorias y la mirada contemplativa de María.

La Necesidad de Contemplación: El Rosario debe de ser una oración exquisitamente contemplativa. “Sin la contemplación el Rosario es un cuerpo sin alma y corre el riesgo de convertirse en una repetición mecánica de fórmulas (Beato Papa Pablo VI). El Rosario exige un ritmo tranquilo y persistente, ya que la persona medita sobre los misterios para que sus riquezas insondables se revelen. “El Rosario” es una forma de contemplación centrada en Cristo (Beato Papa Pablo VI)

María Nos Enseña: Cristo es el revelador y el que se revela. Además de aprender su enseñanza, debemos aprender acerca de El. El Maestro interior es el espíritu que nos lleva a la verdad plena (John 14:26; 15:26; 16:13). Entre todas las criaturas, María conoce a Cristo perfectamente y nos introduce en un profundo conocimiento de su misterio. ... Además de enseñarnos, María ofrece ejemplos de su propia "peregrinación de fe". Mientras contemplamos cada misterio, ella nos alienta a hacer preguntas como ella lo hizo. Esto le ayudo a Maria a decir: “Aquí esta tu esclava del Señor, que me suceda como tú dices.”
