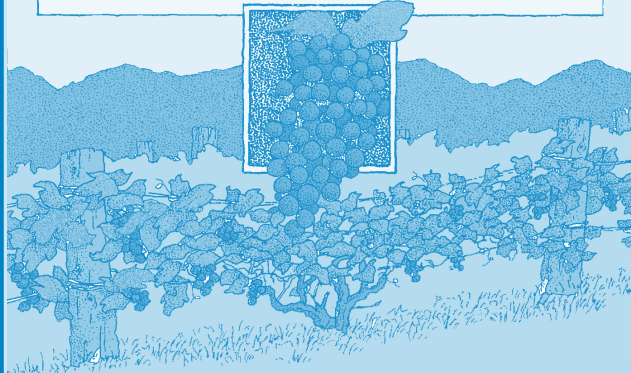

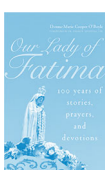
LIFE GIVING LOVE - October 21 & 22
