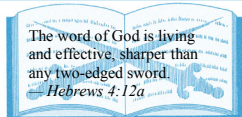

PASTOR'S CORNER

THE HOW OF HOLINESS (Part 9). I have been describing an effective way of sharing a meal with Jesus called, **Prayer of the Heart.** To respond well to Jesus' loving initiative of "knocking on the door of my heart," (see Rev. 3:20), I must prioritize a minimum of 20 – 30 minutes for personal heart-to-heart conversation with Jesus, preferably near the beginning of each day. Prayer of the Heart should become the **"anchor of my spiritual life."** If done well, it will animate all the other prayerful disciplines that contribute to a deepening personal friendship with Jesus and communion with the Trinity and all the saints: Regular Worship at Mass, Adoration, Confession, Scripture Study, Spiritual Reading, Daily Rosary, Chaplet of Divine Mercy, Conscience Exam, Faith Sharing, Works of Mercy and Fellowship with my brothers and sisters in Christ. Consider that if Prayer of the Heart is lacking, my love-motive for cultivating the other disciplines will diminish and I will be vulnerable to settling for a weak, luke-warm, minimal form of cultural Catholicism. Jesus compared this to his gift of the seed of Faith falling on the foot path, rocky ground, or among thorns. When trials come, luke-warm trust in God will fail.

Recall that the First Step for entering into Prayer of the Heart is to FOCUS ON BLESSINGS: 1) blessings of creation, 2) blessings of my life-family-friends-and-vocation, 3) blessings of Redemption, and 4) blessings of the last 24 hours. I have described the first three categories in previous Pastor's Corners. In category 4, I think back 24 hours to the previous morning. I allow the Holy Spirit to bring to my mind all the blessings that whizzed by, often without me saying thank you. I take a minute to remedy that with some praise and thanksgiving. Taking 8 to 10 minutes to focus on the four categories of blessings puts me in touch with the really-real and the eternal. It gives me perspective. I affirm the reality that I am infinitely loved, fearfully, wonderfully made and that there are three Divine Persons who have unspeakable affection for me. I am now ready to proceed to the Second Step in my shared meal with Jesus. Stay tuned.

RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

EL CÓMO DE LA SANTIDAD (Parte 9). He estado describiendo una manera efectiva de compartir una comida con Jesús llamada, **Oración del Corazón**. Para responder bien a la iniciativa amorosa de Jesús de "llamar a la puerta de mi corazón" (ver Apocalipsis 3:20), debo priorizar un mínimo de 20 a 30 minutos para una conversación personal de corazón a corazón con Jesús, preferiblemente al comenzar cada día. La oración del corazón debe convertirse en el "**ancla de mi vida espiritual**". Si se hace bien, animará todas las demás disciplinas de oración que contribuyen a profundizar la amistad con Jesús y la comunión con la Trinidad y todos los Santos: Participación regular en la Misa, Adoración, Confesión, Estudio de las Escrituras, Lectura Espiritual, Rosario diario, Coronilla de la Divina Misericordia, Examen de Conciencia, Compartir la Fe, Obras de Misericordia y Compañerismo con mis hermanos y hermanas en Cristo. Considere que, si falta la Oración del Corazón, mi motivación amorosa para cultivar las otras disciplinas disminuirá y seré vulnerable a conformarme con una forma débil, tibia y mínima de Catolicismo cultural. Jesús comparó esto con su don de la semilla de la fe que cae en el sendero del pie, en el suelo rocoso o entre las espinas. Cuando vengan las pruebas, la confianza tibia en Dios fracasará.

Recuerde que el Primer Paso para entrar en la Oración del Corazón es ENFOCAR LAS BENDICIONES: 1) las bendiciones de la creación, 2) las bendiciones de mi vida-familia-amigos-y-vocación, 3) las bendiciones de la Redención y 4) las bendiciones de las últimas 24 horas. He descrito las tres primeras categorías en los Rincones del Párroco anteriores. En la categoría 4, pienso en las últimas 24 horas de la mañana anterior. Permiso que el Espíritu Santo traiga a mi mente todas las bendiciones que pasaron, muchas sin dar las gracias. Tómese un minuto para remediar eso con un poco de alabanza y acción de gracias. Tomar de 8 a 10 minutos para concentrarme en las cuatro categorías de bendiciones me pone en contacto con lo real y lo eterno. Me da la perspectiva. Afirmo la realidad de que soy infinitamente amado, temeroso, maravillosamente hecho y que hay tres Personas Divinas que tienen un afecto indescriptible por mí. Ahora estoy listo para pasar al Segundo Paso en mi comida compartida con Jesús. Estad atentos.
