PASTOR'S CORNER

OCTOBER IS RESPECT LIFE MONTH - THE MONTH OF THE ROSARY. Of course, we should be praying the rosary daily and respecting life 365 days per year. The Church uses October to specially remind us of the anti-life forces that are undermining our culture and of the powerful spiritual weapons we can use to defeat those forces. The tide is shifting. Now in the U.S. there are more Pregnancy Resource Centers than there are abortion sites. In the past five years 154 abortion sites have closed. Many of these victories of life over death are due to the prayer, fasting and public witness of annual Fall and Spring 40 Days for Life Campaigns, and the week by week side-walk counseling of pro-life ministries, such as Esperanza de Vida in our own parish. But this is no time to rest. The equivalent of the 9-11 terror attack which killed over 3,000 innocents in 2001, is still happening each day in our country with the war on the unborn. Here are three rosary mystery introductions written by Fr. Frank Pavone of Priests for Life:

The Resurrection: Christ is Risen! By His Resurrection, He has destroyed the power of death, and therefore the power of abortion. The outcome of the battle for Life has already been decided: Life is victorious! Let us pray that all pro-lifers will spread this victory to every segment of our society.

The Ascension: By ascending to the Father's throne, Christ takes our human nature, given to us in the womb, to the heights of heaven. He shows us that human beings are made to be raised to heaven, not thrown in the garbage. Let us pray that the world may learn this truth and reject abortion.

The Coronation: Mary is the Queen of the Universe. The Church teaches that she is the greatest creature, second only to God Himself. The Church defends the dignity of women. We pray that people will understand that to be pro-life means to be pro-woman, and that to be pro-woman demands that we be pro-life.

For women and men who have been hurt by the evil of abortion, please encounter the healing and peace of Christ in the Sacrament of Confession. Please see the bulletin notice for the upcoming Rachel's Vineyard Retreat November 10-12 (English) in Fresno.

RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

OCTUBRE ES EL MES DEL RESPETO A LA VIDA - EL MES DEL ROSARIO. Por supuesto, debemos rezar el rosario diariamente y respetar la vida 365 días al año. La Iglesia usa octubre para recordarnos especialmente las fuerzas anti-vida que están socavando nuestra cultura y las poderosas armas espirituales que podemos usar para derrotar a esas fuerzas. La marea está cambiando. Ahora en los Estados Unidos hay más Centros de Recursos de Embarazo que sitios de aborto. En los últimos cinco años 154 sitios de aborto han cerrado. Muchas de estas victorias de la vida sobre la muerte se deben a la oración, el ayuno y el testimonio público de las campañas anuales de Otoño y Primavera 40 Días por la Vida, y la orientación semanal de los ministerios favorables a la vida, como Esperanza de Vida en nuestra propia parroquia. Pero no hay es tiempo para descansar. El equivalente al ataque terrorista del 9-11 que mató a más de 3.000 inocentes en el 2001, sigue ocurriendo cada día en nuestro país con la guerra contra los niños por nacer. Aquí hay tres presentaciones de los misterios del rosario escritas por el P. Frank Pavone de los sacerdotes para la vida:

La Resurrección: ¡Cristo ha resucitado! Por su Resurrección, Él ha destruido el poder de la muerte, y por ende el poder del aborto. El resultado de la batalla por la Vida ya se decidido: ¡La Vida es victoriosa! Oremos para que todos los que luchan por la vida puedan extender esta victoria a cada rincón de nuestra sociedad.

La Ascensión: Al Ascender al Trono de Dios Padre, Cristo toma nuestra naturaleza humana, la cual nos fue dada en el vientre de nuestras Madres, y la lleva hacia lo más alto del cielo. Él nos demuestra que los seres humanos hemos sido creados para ser elevados al cielo y no para ser descartados al fondo de los basureros. Oremos para que el mundo entero comprenda esta verdad y rechace el aborto.

La Coronación: Santa María es la Reina del Universo. Ella es la criatura más grande, segunda solo al mismo Dios. La Iglesia defiende la dignidad de la mujer. Oremos para que la gente comprenda que ser pro vida significa ser pro mujer, y que ser pro mujer exige ser pro vida.
