PASTOR'S CORNER

THE HOW OF HOLINESS (Part 10). The FIRST STEP of PRAYER OF THE HEART, with its focus on blessings, praise and thanksgiving, gives me perspective on life and reality. To review my commentary on the FIRST STEP in previous Pastor's Corners, you may go to the Parish Web-Site: www.sjoachim.org.

I am now ready to allow the Holy Spirit to guide me through eight to ten minutes of THE SECOND STEP of PRAYER OF THE HEART, which has three parts: 1) I confide in Jesus my difficulties, fears, anxieties and needs; 2) out of my unique personal circumstances and needs, I ask Jesus a question, seeking his guidance; 3) I make myself listen for five minutes as I pray, "*Speak, Lord, your servant is listening.*"

In part-1, I must admit that Jesus knows me better than I know myself. The effort to confide my needs to Jesus gives me the benefit of growing in self-knowledge. In light of Jesus loving me first and always by his total Self-Gift, to me and to every other poor sinner, on the Cross, I make the effort to respond with my self-gift, entrusting my needs to him and seeking his guidance.

In part-2, my personal question can trigger a time of good listening. If I do not ask Jesus a question, I don't hear much. Thus, **the question**, arising out of my unique circumstances and needs, is extremely important. It expresses my desire to receive Jesus' counsel. I am encouraged by Jesus' promise to every disciple, "The one who asks, receives. The one who seeks, finds. My sheep hear my voice and they follow me." (Mt. 7:7; Jn. 10:3).

In part-3 I must trust Jesus' promise and try to listen for his response to my question. No one can listen for me. Each disciple must learn to hear Jesus' "still small voice." Jesus speaks in this way because of the logic of love. He desires to maintain my dignity as a person with free-will, so that I can participate in authentic love, the giving and receiving of self-gift, even the receiving of Divine Self-Gift. As thoughts come to me and begin to ring true through Jesus' "still-small-voice," I write them down on a handy note pad at my prayer site in a spirit of ready obedience. I must discern and make sure that Jesus' personal counsel to me is in harmony with his public revelation to the whole human race through Sacred Tradition, Sacred Scripture and the Teaching Authority of the Church. In this way I can receive the best counsel in the universe directly from Jesus, the Good Shepherd. Next week we will reflect on STEP THREE of PRAYER OF THE HEART. Stay tuned.

RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

EL CÓMO DE LA SANTIDAD (Parte 10).

EL PRIMER PASO de la ORACIÓN DEL CORAZÓN, con el enfoque en las bendiciones, la alabanza y el agradecimiento, me da una perspectiva de la vida y la realidad. Para revisar mi comentario sobre el PRIMER PASO en los Rincones del Párroco anteriores, puede visitar el sitio web de la parroquia: www.sjoachim.org.

Ahora estoy listo para permitir que el Espíritu Santo me guíe durante ocho a diez minutos de EL SEGUNDO PASO DE LA ORACION DEL CORAZÓN, que consta de tres partes: 1) Confío en Jesús mis dificultades, temores, ansiedades y necesidades; 2) fuera de mis circunstancias y necesidades personales únicas, le hago una pregunta a Jesús, buscando su guía; 3) Me hago escuchar durante cinco minutos mientras rezo: “*Habla Señor, que tu siervo escucha*”.

En la parte 1, debo admitir que Jesús me conoce mejor que yo mismo. El esfuerzo por confiar mis necesidades a Jesús me da el beneficio de crecer en el autoconocimiento. A la luz de que Jesús me amó primero y siempre por su don de sí mismo total, a mí ya todos los demás pecadores pobres, en la Cruz, hago el esfuerzo de responder con mi don de sí mismo, confiándole mis necesidades y buscando su guía.

En la parte 2, mi pregunta personal puede provocar un momento de escuchar. Si no le hago una pregunta a Jesús, no escucho mucho. Por lo tanto, **la pregunta**, que surge de mis circunstancias y necesidades únicas, es extremadamente importante. Expresa mi deseo de recibir el consejo de Jesús. Me alienta la promesa de Jesús a cada discípulo: “El que pregunta, recibe. El que busca, encuentra. Mis ovejas oyen mi voz y me siguen.” (Mt. 7:7; Jn. 10:3).

En la parte 3 debo confiar en la promesa de Jesús y tratar de escuchar su respuesta a mi pregunta. Nadie puede escuchar por mí. Cada discípulo debe aprender a escuchar la “tranquila pequeña voz” de Jesús. Jesús habla de esta manera debido a la lógica del amor. Él desea mantener mi dignidad como persona con libre albedrío, de modo que pueda participar en el amor auténtico, en dar y recibir el don de sí mismo, incluso en el recibimiento del Divino Don de sí mismo. A medida que los pensamientos se acercan a mí y comienzan a sonar verdaderos a través de la “tranquila pequeña voz” de Jesús, los escribo en un cuaderno de notas en mi sitio de oración con un espíritu de obediencia. Debo discernir y asegurarme de que el consejo personal de Jesús para mí esté en armonía con su revelación pública a toda la raza humana a través de la Tradición Sagrada, la Sagrada Escritura y la Autoridad de enseñanza de la Iglesia. De esta manera, puedo recibir el mejor consejo del universo directamente de Jesús, el Buen Pastor.

La próxima semana reflexionaremos sobre el PASO TRES de la ORACIÓN DEL CORAZÓN. Manténganse al tanto.
