PASTOR'S CORNER

THE HOW OF HOLINESS (part 11). In previous Pastor's Corners I have described a three step dynamic for an effective daily heart to heart communication with Jesus: Step 1) Eight to ten minutes Focusing on blessings of creation, life, redemption and the last 24 hours, with a response of gratitude and praise; Step 2) Eight to ten minutes confiding in Jesus my difficulties and needs, asking him a question and listening for his response; Step 3) Eight to ten minutes praying with great compassion for others.

Today I will describe Step 3 in more detail. The Holy Spirit is the Self-Gift of the Father and Jesus to every disciple. Saint Paul states, "*God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit which has been given us*" (Romans 5:5). The Holy Spirit is God's personal, merciful Love for all who sin and suffer, now poured into my heart. In Step 3 of PRAYER OF THE HEART, I allow that Love to overflow as I intercede with great compassion for those in need: special intentions, members of my family, my friends, the church, the poor, the needy, the sick, and all my fellow poor sinners on the face of the earth and in purgatory. Jesus teaches us to ask, seek and knock, without losing heart, trusting in the goodness of our Father (see Luke 11: 1-13). St. Paul urges us: "*At every opportunity pray in the Spirit, with all prayer and supplication. Pray constantly and attentively for all in the holy company. Pray for me that God may put his word on my lips, that I may courageously make known the mystery of the gospel*" (Eph. 6:18-20). Our Lady of Fatima told us, "*Pray, pray very much, and make sacrifices for sinners; for many souls go to hell, because there are none to sacrifice themselves and to pray for them.*" Intercessory prayer is a spiritual work of mercy that readies me for corporal works of mercy-sacrifices as opportunities present themselves in the hours and days ahead. I find it helpful to, not only pray for categories of the needy, but, to also make a prayer list of needy persons that I want to remember by name. Step 3 of PRAYER OF THE HEART enables my deeper intimacy with the Trinity to lead to a more loving communion with my fellow saints-under construction on earth and in purgatory.

RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

EL CÓMO DE LA SANTIDAD (parte 11). En los Rincones del Párroco anteriores, describí una dinámica de tres pasos para una comunicación eficaz y diaria de corazón a corazón con Jesús: Paso 1) De ocho a diez minutos enfocándome en las bendiciones de la creación, la vida, la redención y las últimas 24 horas, con una respuesta de gratitud y alabanza; Paso 2) De ocho a diez minutos confiando en Jesús mis dificultades y necesidades, haciéndole una pregunta y escuchando su respuesta; Paso 3) Ocho a diez minutos orando con gran compasión por los demás.

Hoy voy a describir el Paso 3 con más detalle. El Espíritu Santo es el regalo propio del Padre y de Jesús a cada discípulo. San Pablo dice: "La cual no quedará frustrada, pues ya se nos ha dado el Espíritu Santo, y por él el amor de Dios se va derramando en nuestros corazones." (Romanos 5:5). El Espíritu Santo es el amor personal y misericordioso de Dios por todos los que pecan y sufren, ahora se derrama en mi corazón. En el Paso 3 de la ORACIÓN DEL CORAZÓN, permito que el Amor se desborde al interceder con gran compasión por los necesitados: intenciones especiales, miembros de mi familia, mis amigos, la iglesia, los pobres, los necesitados, los enfermos y todos mis compañeros pobres pecadores sobre la faz de la tierra y en el purgatorio. Jesús nos enseña a pedir, buscar y llamar, sin perder el corazón, confiando en la bondad de nuestro Padre (ver Lucas 11:1-13). San Pablo nos exhorta: "Vivan orando y suplicando. Oren en todo tiempo según les inspire el Espíritu. Velen en común y perseveren en sus oraciones sin desanimarse nunca, intercediendo en favor de todos los santos, sus hermanos. Rueguen también por mí, para que, al hablar, se me den palabras y no me falte el coraje para dar a conocer el misterio del Evangelio cuando tenga que presentar mi defensa, pues yo soy embajador encadenado de este Evangelio." (Efesios 6:18-20). Nuestra Señora de Fátima nos dijo: "Oren, oren mucho y hagan sacrificios por los pecadores; porque muchas almas van al infierno, porque no hay nadie que se sacrifique y ore por ellos." La oración intercesora es una obra espiritual de misericordia que me prepara para las obras corporales de misericordia-sacrificios como oportunidades que se presentan en las horas y días que vienen. Me resulta útil, no solo orar por las categorías de los necesitados, sino también, hacer una lista de oración de las personas necesitadas que quiero recordar por nombre en la tierra y en el purgatorio.
