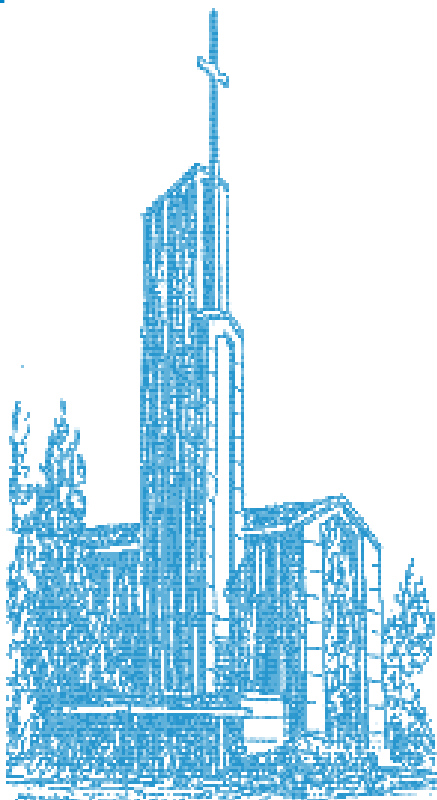

PASTOR'S CORNER

"I am the Lady of the Rosary. Continue always to pray the Rosary every day. Do not offend the Lord our God any more, because He is already so much offended." October 13, 2017 marked the 100th anniversary of these words of Mary to the three shepherd children in Fatima, and through them, to the world. We dare not let our Lady's request fade from our minds and our hearts now that the Centennial Celebration is past. Indeed, the Message of Our Lady of Fatima, sometimes called, "the Peace Plan from Heaven," is as relevant today as it was in 1917. To aid us in this, I intend to use the "Pastor's Corner" in some of the weeks ahead to highlight certain quotes from Letter on the Rosary by Saint John Paul II.

"Two Great Needs – Peace and the Family: A revival of the Rosary is timely because we must pray for peace. This millennium witnesses fresh scenes of bloodshed every day. The Rosary immerses us in Christ who has "broken down the wall of hostility (Eph.2:14). Anyone saying the Rosary must feel a clear commitment to peace, especially in the Holy Land.

The family also is so menaced by forces of disintegration that we fear for its future and even for the future of society. Reviving the family Rosary will help to counter the devastating effects of our age."

"I have felt drawn to write this reflection because to recite the Rosary is to *contemplate with Mary the face of Christ*. The Rosary goes to the heart of Christian life and offers a fruitful opportunity for Christian contemplation, formation and evangelization." 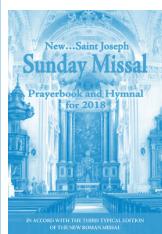

El 13 de Octubre de 2017 se conmemoró el centenario de estas palabras de María a los tres niños pastorcitos en Fátima y, a través de ellos, al mundo. No nos atrevamos a dejar que la petición de nuestra Señora se desvanezca de nuestras mentes y nuestros corazones ahora que la celebración del Centenario ha pasado. De hecho, el Mensaje de Nuestra Señora de Fátima, a veces llamado "el Plan de Paz desde el Cielo", es tan relevante hoy como lo fué en 1917.
