PASTOR'S CORNER

THE HOW OF THE HOLINESS (Part 8). The essence of holiness comes from communion with our Holy God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. **PRAYER OF THE HEART** is what makes our communion with God **PERSONAL**. I am in the midst of describing the first of three steps in a daily discipline of a minimum of 20 - 30 minutes of **HEART TO HEART CONVERSATION WITH GOD**. Recall from Part 7 that the first step requires a conscious 8 – 10 minute focus on **BLESSINGS**. Allow the Holy Spirit to bring to mind and heart, (1) blessings of the glories of creation and, (2) blessings of life-family-and-friends. Allow **GRATITUDE AND PRAISE** to rise in your heart. Next, focus on the **BLESSINGS OF REDEMPTION**. I recommend a minimum 2-minute meditation on the Passion of Jesus, because the measure of his suffering is the measure of his sacrificial love for each of us. **There was no greater suffering and there is no greater love!** In my imagination I accompany Jesus to the Garden of Gethsemane. He began to sweat blood in anticipation of the horrible suffering that lay ahead. Medical experts explain that “sweating blood” occurs when a human heart begins to rupture. In His human nature He prayed that the chalice of suffering be removed, yet He trusted in his Father’s will and leaned into the divine plan of redemption. He was beaten, spat upon and mocked throughout His arrest and trial. Pilate had Him scourged. The Shroud of Turin shows 300 open wounds from the terrible scourging. The soldiers crushed a clump of 4-inch thorns into His scalp as a mock crown. They tied His arms to a heavy cross-beam and pushed Him toward Calvary. He fell multiple times with nothing to break His fall. Simon of Cyrene was forced to help Him lest He die before reaching the place of crucifixion. They pounded nails through His wrists and His feet. He agonized upon the cross for six hours. Shortly before His last breath He prayed, **FATHER, FORGIVE THEM; THEY KNOW NOT WHAT THEY DO!** On the third day He rose from the dead and returned to the world that crucified him with the words, **PEACE BE WITH YOU. RECEIVE THE HOLY SPIRIT!** Jesus invites all human beings to be baptized into HIM; to receive mercy, forgiveness, HIS VERY SELF, His victory over sin, death and the devil, His friendship, His mission, and abundant life in his eternal Kingdom. Allow gratitude and praise to fill your heart. Make the sign of the cross and say, **“Jesus, I would rather die than offend you. Give me the grace to always please you.”** (more to come.)

RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

EL CÓMO DE LA SANTIDAD (Parte 8). La esencia de la santidad viene de la comunión con nuestro santo Dios, Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo. **ORACIÓN DEL CORAZÓN** es lo que hace que nuestra comunión con Dios **PERSONAL**. Estoy en medio de describir el primero de tres pasos en una disciplina diaria de un mínimo de 20-30 minutos de **CONVERSACIÓN DE CORAZÓN A CORAZÓN CON DIOS**. Recordar en la parte 7 que el primer paso requiere un enfoque consciente de 8 – 10 minutos en **BENDICIONES**. Permitan al Espíritu Santo traer a la mente y al corazón, (1) las bendiciones de las glorias de la creación y, (2) las bendiciones de la vida-familia-y-amigos. Permite **GRATITUD Y ALABANZA** a elevarse en tu corazón. A continuación, enfóquese en las **BENDICIONES DE REDENCIÓN**. Recomiendo una meditación mínima de 2 minutos sobre la pasión de Jesús, porque la medida de su sufrimiento es la medida de su amor sacrificial por cada uno de nosotros. **No hubo mayor sufrimiento y no hay mayor amor!** En mi imaginación acompaño a Jesús al huerto de Getsemaní. Empezó a sudar sangre en previsión del horrible sufrimiento que había por delante. Los expertos médicos explican que "sudar sangre" ocurre cuando un corazón humano comienza a romperse. En su naturaleza humana oró para que el cáliz del sufrimiento fuera eliminado, pero confió en la voluntad de su padre y se inclinó en el plan divino de redención. Fue golpeado, escupido y burlado a lo largo de su arresto y juicio. Pilato lo hizo azotar. El Sudario de Turín muestra 300 heridas abiertas de la terrible flagelación. Los soldados aplastaron un grupo de espinas de 4 pulgadas en su cuero cabelludo como una corona falsa. Ataron sus brazos a una pesada viga transversal y lo empujaron hacia el Calvario. Se cayó varias veces sin nada para prevenir su caída. Simón de Cirene se vio obligado a ayudarlo a no ser que muriera antes de llegar al lugar de la crucifixión. Golpearon clavos a través de sus muñecas y sus pies. Agonizaba en la Cruz durante seis horas. Poco antes de su último suspiro oró, **PADRE, PERDÓNALOS; ¡NO SABEN LO QUE HACEN!** Al tercer día resucitó de entre los muertos y regresó al mundo que lo había crucificado con las palabras, **LA PAZ SEA CONTIGO. ¡RECIBAN EL ESPÍRITU SANTO!** Jesús invita a todos los seres humanos a ser bautizados en él; para recibir misericordia, perdón, su propio ser, su victoria sobre el pecado, la muerte y el diablo, su amistad, su misión, y la vida abundante en su reino eterno. Permitan gratitud y alabanza para llenar su corazón. Haz el signo de la Cruz y di: **“Jesús, preferiría morir antes que ofenderte. Dame la gracia de siempre agradecerte por favor.** (más por venir.)
