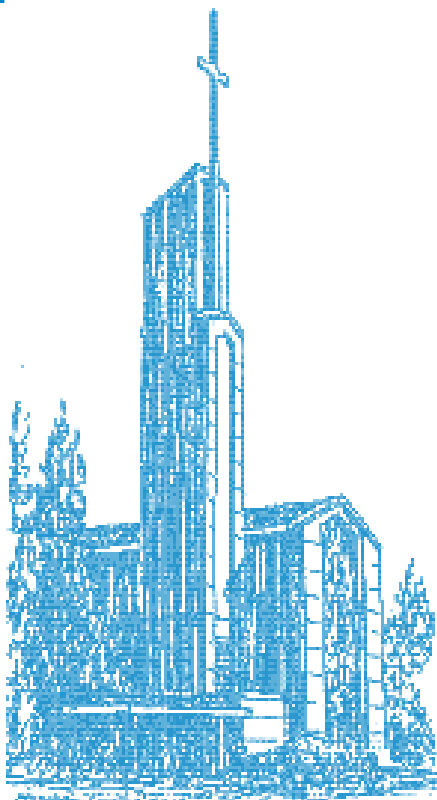

PASTOR'S CORNER

100th Anniversary of the 5th Apparition of Our Lady of Fatima to the three shepherd children, September 13, 1917. "While, on the one hand, there were many who had made every effort to put a stop to the "farce" of the Cova da Iria, on the other hand, the number of those who believed in the apparitions was growing rapidly. Thus, on the 13th of September, about 25,000 people were present for the appointment with Our Lady. "What do you want of me?" asked Lucia, as usual. "Continue to pray the Rosary," our Lady said, "in order to obtain the end of the war. ... In October, I will perform a miracle so that all may believe." ... In Aljustrel itself where the children lived, the majority of the people were disbelieving and hostile. Priests and members of their own families, tried to persuade the little seers to admit they had lied." (from the booklet, Fatima, Place of Hope and Peace).

What about us? What about me? Do I find myself to be disbelieving, or, indifferent, to the message of Our Lady and the events that took place in Fatima, one hundred years ago? Am I making an effort to pray the Rosary daily for the conversion of poor sinners, beginning with myself? Praying the Rosary well means that I am choosing to use a very effective means, given from Heaven to St. Dominic, for meditating on 20 mysteries at the very heart of the Gospel, for the transformation of my mind and the deeper conversion of my heart. Praying the Rosary daily engages me in a spiritual work of mercy to cooperate with God's plan for the conversion of all my fellow poor sinners on the face of the earth and in purgatory. Praying the Rosary daily helps bring God's Peace to my own heart and to the world.

Centenario de la 5ª aparición de Nuestra Señora de Fátima a los tres niños pastores, 13 de Septiembre del 1917.

“Mientras que, por un lado, había muchos que habían hecho todo lo posible para poner fin a la “farsa” de la Cova da Iría, por otra parte, el número de los que creyeron en las apariciones estaba creciendo rápidamente. Así, el 13 de Septiembre, cerca de 25.000 personas estuvieron presentes para la cita con Nuestra Señora. “¿Qué quieres de mí?” preguntó Lucía, como de costumbre. “Continúen rezando el Rosario”, dijo Nuestra Señora, “para obtener el fin de la guerra. ... En Octubre, haré un milagro para que todos crean.” ... En Aljustrel, donde vivían los niños, la mayoría de la gente era incrédula y hostil. Sacerdotes y miembros de sus propias familias trataron de convencer a los pequeños videntes de que habían mentado.” (del folleto, Fátima, Lugar de Esperanza y Paz).

¿Qué pasa con nosotros? ¿Que hay de mí? ¿No doy crédito o soy indiferente al mensaje de Nuestra Señora y los acontecimientos que tuvieron lugar en Fátima hace cien años? ¿Estoy haciendo un esfuerzo para orar diariamente el Rosario por la conversión de los pobres pecadores, empezando por mí mismo? Rezar bien el Rosario significa que estoy escogiendo utilizar un medio muy efectivo, dado desde el Cielo a San Domingo, para meditar en los 20 misterios en el mismo corazón del Evangelio, para la transformación de mi mente y la conversión más profunda de mi corazón. Rezar el Rosario me involucra a diario en una obra espiritual de misericordia para cooperar con el plan de Dios para la conversión de todos mis compañeros pobres pecadores sobre la faz de la tierra y en el purgatorio. Rezar el Rosario diariamente ayuda a traer la Paz de Dios a mi propio corazón y al mundo.
