PASTOR'S CORNER

THE HOW OF HOLINESS (Part 6). Today I will describe the first course in a daily practical three-course “*shared meal*” with Jesus (cf. Rev. 3:20). If you are a beginner in the discipline of PRAYER OF THE HEART, try to avoid the most common beginner’s mistake, the tendency to pray spontaneously. This usually results in praying out of one’s feelings. I can tell you that most of the strongest and closest-to-the-surface feelings, at the beginning of my day, are negative. “*I feel tired. I did not get enough sleep. I feel stressed because I am behind in achieving deadlines and returning phone calls. I feel anxiety over certain relationships wounded by anger and frustration.*” If I start with my feelings, my prayer time will become a negative time of complaint, causing discouragement, and then, I will quit praying. To avoid this, I use THE PRAYER OF SURRENDER, a deep act of Faith, Hope and Love, as my diving board into personal prayer (see Pastor’s Corner 9-2-18). In the first course I must use my free will to **FOCUS on BLESSINGS**. I divide my BLESSINGS into four categories and allow the Holy Spirit to bring certain blessings to mind and to heart. **Words and emotions of praise and thanksgiving spontaneously arise.** The blessing-categories I use are: 1) the glories-of-creation; 2) my life-family-friends; 3) redemption through the sacrificial love of Jesus; and 4) the last 24 hours. I give myself eight to ten minutes for the Holy Spirit to take me through these categories. This first course of prayer-of-the-heart puts me in touch with the really-real and the eternal; it puts me powerfully in touch with God, Father-Son-and-Holy-Spirit. It puts the negativity in my life into perspective. It gives me a profound awareness that I am infinitely loved, fearfully-wonderfully made, and that there are three Divine Persons who have unspeakable affection for me. Next week I will go into more detail on how the Holy Spirit leads through the four categories. Stay tuned.

RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

EL CÓMO DE LA SANTIDAD (parte 6). Hoy voy a describir el primer curso en una práctica diaria de tres cursos "comida compartida" con Jesús (cf. Rev. 3:20). Si usted es un principiante en la disciplina de la ORACIÓN DEL CORAZÓN, trate de evitar el error de principiante más común, la tendencia a orar espontáneamente. Esto usualmente resulta en orar de los sentimientos de uno. Puedo decirles que la mayoría de los sentimientos más fuertes y cercanos a la superficie, al comienzo de mi día, son negativos. "Me siento cansado. No dormí lo suficiente. Me siento estresado porque estoy atrasado en el logro de los plazos y de regresar las llamadas telefónicas. Siento ansiedad por ciertas relaciones heridas por la ira y la frustración." Si empiezo con mis sentimientos, mi tiempo de oración se convertirá en un tiempo negativo de queja, causando desánimo, y entonces, dejaré de orar. Para evitar esto, utilizo LA ORACIÓN DE LA ENTREGA, un acto profundo de la fe, de la esperanza y del amor, como mi trampolín en la oración personal (véase el Rincón del Párroco del 9-2-18). En el primer curso debo usar mi libre albedrío para **CONCENTRARME EN LAS BENDICIONES**. Divido mis BENDICIONES en cuatro categorías y permito que el Espíritu Santo traiga ciertas bendiciones a la mente y al corazón. **Palabras y emociones de alabanza y acción de gracias surgen espontáneamente.** Las categorías de bendición que utilizo son: 1) las glorias de la creación; 2) mi vida-familia-amigos; 3) redención a través del amor sacrificial de Jesús; y 4) las últimas 24 horas. Me doy de ocho a diez minutos para que el Espíritu Santo me lleve a través de estas categorías. Este primer curso de oración del corazón me pone en contacto con lo real y lo eterno; me pone poderosamente en contacto con Dios, padre-hijo-y-Espíritu Santo. Pone la negatividad en mi vida en perspectiva. Me da una conciencia profunda de que soy infinitamente amado, hecho maravillosamente-temeroso, y que hay tres personas divinas que tienen afecto indecible por mí. La semana que viene voy a entrar en más detalles sobre cómo el Espíritu Santo me conduce a través de las cuatro categorías. Estad atentos.
