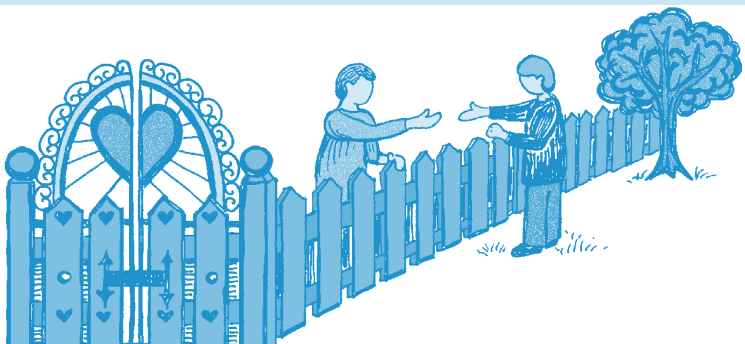

PASTOR'S CORNER

"We exist for the praise of his glory!" (Ephesians 1:12)

The comparison below fills me with reverent awe and causes the spirit of gratitude, wonder and praise to rise within my heart. I often think of this comparison during the first stage of my daily half hour of "prayer of the heart."

(Part I) In years past, I recall boarding jumbo jets and flying thousands of miles on round trips to the Philip-pines or to Singapore/India. A fully loaded Boeing 747 weighs 500 tons, and yet, it flies! One of those great jets is a bundle of electronic, hydraulic, fuel, mechanical, luggage, entertainment and food service systems that function in harmony to create awesome memories for up to 600 passengers.

(Part II) Biologists tell me that just one of the cells on the tip of my finger is like a living factory, loaded with integrated systems of molecules and atoms, with electrons moving at the speed of light. A simple skin cell can make the complexity of a jumbo jet pale in comparison. I'm told that my body is made up of over six trillion cells!

(Part III) Once I visited San Francisco, and from the rooftop of St. Brigid's Convent, I was awed by the spectacle of the Blue Angels, five Navy jets, flying wing-tip to wing-tip at supersonic speeds.

(Part IV) In my imagination I can interchange the macro-jet images from Parts I and III with the micro-cell image of Part II. When I move across the room, I am able to picture my body as six trillion micro-jet-cells flying wing-tip to wing-tip in perfect formation.

Who is holding my six trillion micro-jet-cells in harmony? Pardon me while I succumb to a moment of reverent awe, and then praise the glory of God from the bottom of my heart.

Existimos para la alabanza de su Gloria (Ef. 1:12)

La comparación a continuación me llena de asombro y hace que el espíritu de gratitud, admiración y alabanza se eleve dentro de mi corazón. Con frecuencia pienso de esta comparación durante la primera etapa de mi media hora de "oración del corazón" diaria.

(Parte I). En los últimos años, recuerdo abordar los grandes aviones y volar miles de kilómetros en viajes redondos a las Filipinas o de Singapur a la India. El Boeing 747 lleno pesa aproximadamente 500 toneladas y aún así ¡vuela!. Uno de estos grandes aviones es un conjunto de entretenimiento electrónico e hidráulico, de combustible, mecánico, de equipaje y de sistemas de servicio humano que funcionan en armonía para crear memorias inolvidables para hasta a 600 pasajeros.

(Parte II) Los Biólogos me dicen que solo una de las células en la punta de mi dedo es como una fábrica viviente, cargada con sistemas de moléculas y átomos integrales, con electrones que se mueven a la velocidad de la luz. Una simple célula de la piel puede hacer ver la complejidad de un avión palido en comparación. Me han dicho que mi cuerpo se compone de seis trillones de ¡células!.
