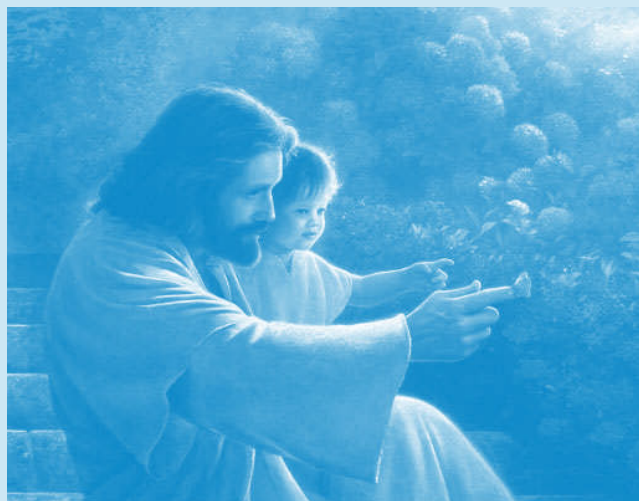

PASTOR'S CORNER

THE DEMON IN THE ROOM - WHAT CAN WE DO? I am interrupting my series on PRAYER OF THE HEART to briefly address this important topic. The horrific national and international clergy sexual abuse and cover-up scandal, in the words of Bishop Barron, *"is a diabolical masterpiece because it undermines the work of the Church in practically every way. ... The work of the Church, as Pope Benedict said, - to worship God, to serve the poor and to evangelize - all three of them are being undermined. ... Which is why we need to come to grips fully with it. We can't rest until the thing has been solved."* And so, **WHAT OUGHT WE TO DO?** Ralph Martin, President of Renewal Ministries, invites this response in his "Letter to Troubled Catholics." *"Unfortunately, the rot is wide and deep and years of covering up abuse and its ultimate exposure has injured the faith of millions. How shocking and tragic it was to see tens of thousands of Irish people in the streets of Dublin wildly celebrating that they could now legally kill babies!!!! Just when the Irish bishops needed to speak most strongly on fundamental moral issues, their credibility was destroyed when it was finally exposed that they had covered up abuse for decades. ... We must pray for the pope and our leaders that God may give them the wisdom and courage to deal with the root of the rot and bring about a real renewal of holiness and evangelization. ... We need to remember that Jesus is the treasure we hold in earthen vessels and He is still as present as ever. ... Let's attend daily Mass even more frequently, to offer the sacrifice of Jesus' death and resurrection to God the Father, in the power of the Holy Spirit, for the salvation of souls and the purification of the Church."* A strong and clear message given through Our Lady of Fatima in 1917 is more relevant than ever: *"Pray, pray very much, and make sacrifices for sinners; for many souls go to hell, because there are none to sacrifice themselves and to pray for them."* My dear parishioners, the demons of sexual immorality have not only affected some members of the clergy but they are mightily at work to destroy persons, marriages and families right here in Madera and throughout the world. I urge all of us to come together in the Fall **40 Days of Prayer for Life Campaign** of fasting, intercession, reparation and witness, between September 25 and November 4. I urge us to pray the rosary daily, as families when possible, and to participate in **our parish Holy Hour and Rosary on October 7**, the Feast of our Lady of the Rosary.

EL DEMONIO EN LA HABITACIÓN - ¿QUÉ PODEMOS HACER? Estoy interrumpiendo mi serie sobre LA ORACIÓN DEL CORAZÓN para abordar brevemente este importante tema. El horroroso escándalo sexual y de encubrimiento del clero nacional e internacional, en palabras del obispo Barron, " *es una obra maestra diabólica porque mina el trabajo de la iglesia en prácticamente todos los sentidos. ... Justo cuando los obispos irlandeses necesitaban hablar con más fuerza sobre cuestiones morales fundamentales, su credibilidad fué destruida cuando finalmente se expuso que habian cubierto el abuso durante decenios. ... Debemos orar por el Papa y nuestros líderes para que Dios les dé la sabiduría y el coraje para lidiar con la raíz de la podredumbre y lograr una renovación real de la santidad y la evangelización.... Tenemos que recordar que Jesús es el tesoro que guardamos en las vasijas de tierra y él sigue siendo tan presente como siempre. ... Asistamos a la Misa diaria con más frecuencia, para ofrecer el sacrificio de la muerte y resurrección de Jesús a Dios Padre, en el poder del Espíritu Santo, para la salvación de las almas y la purificación de la iglesia.* Un mensaje fuerte y claro dado a través de nuestra Señora de Fátima en 1917 es más relevante que nunca: *"Oren, oren mucho, y hagan sacrificios por los pecadores; porque muchas almas van al infierno, porque no hay ninguno para sacrificarse y orar por ellos."* Queridos feligreses, los demonios de la inmoralidad sexual no sólo han afectado a algunos miembros del clero, sino que están trabajando con fuerza para destruir a las personas, los matrimonios y las familias aquí mismo en madera y en todo el mundo. Insto a todos a que nos juntemos en el otoño a la Campaña **40 Días de Oración por la Vida** de ayuno, intercesión, reparación y testimonio, entre el 25 de septiembre y el 4 de noviembre. Les pido orar el Rosario diariamente, como familias cuando sea posible, y a participar en **nuestra Hora Santa parroquial y Rosario el 7 de octubre**, la fiesta de nuestra Señora del Rosario.
