PASTOR'S CORNER

THE HOW OF HOLINESS (Part 7). My first step in the daily discipline of PRAYER OF THE HEART is to focus on blessings and to allow the Holy Spirit to guide me through four categories: 1) the glories-of-creation; 2) my life-family-friends; 3) redemption through the sacrificial love of Jesus; and 4) the last 24 hours. When I focus on the glories-of-creation, I allow beautiful memories of the universe to flood my imagination. Different ones come to mind on different days. Some days I try to imagine the Big Bang with the light show of expanding galaxies, solar systems and planets. As I focus on planet Earth, I praise God for the **BEAUTY** of Yosemite, Bryce, Zion, Grand Canyon, Monterey Bay, the glorious vista of palm trees, pond and reeds from the tenth Tee Box of Madera Municipal Golf Course, Assisi, St. Peter's Basilica, Bavaria, Maui, etc. I thank God that I am part of the beauty of his creation. I give myself a minimum of two minutes of gratitude and praise in this first category. Next, I give myself at least two minutes to consider the blessings in category 2: my life, my family and my friends. I thank God that my human nature is a marriage of the invisible and the visible. I have a transcendent self that is able to perceive, understand, decide, know, reason and act. Given my intellect and free will, I can actually receive love and give love, from and to, other persons, even Divine Persons. I allow personal thoughts and images of family members, friends, confreres in my religious community, brothers and sisters in Christ in the parish, to flood my mind and heart. I thank God for calling and enabling me to be a ministerial priest of Jesus Christ and an Oblate of St. Joseph. Indeed, after just four minutes of focusing on the blessings of creation, life-family-and -friends, my cup is overflowing with gratitude and praise. But, the best is yet to come. Stay tuned for next week as I share what it is like to focus on the blessings of redemption and the last twenty-four hours.

HOLY LAND

"A group from the Holy Land (Bethlehem & Jerusalem) will be selling religious articles after masses to support the Catholic Christian minorities in Bethlehem. As a tradition, many of the Catholic families in the Holy Land work in small workshops to produce religious articles from olive wood. These articles represent the Christian art of the Holy Land. In the past, they used to sell their artwork to pilgrims who visit the Holy Land. However, these days they are facing an economic hardship as very few tourists visit the Holy Land due to security issues. Many of the Catholic families immigrated and left the Holy Land. The percentage of Christians in the Holy Land has dropped from 20% to less than 2%. Therefore, if this hardship continues as it is now, we believe that in a few years, there will be no Catholics in Bethlehem or Jerusalem. The struggle to preserve the Catholic identity of the birthplace of our savior; Jesus Christ is a serious concern for Catholics around the world. Sales will be used to help and support the Catholics in the Holy Land and to encourage them not to immigrate."
