PASTOR'S CORNER

THE HOW OF HOLINESS (Part 5). PRAYER OF THE HEART ought to be the daily ANCHOR of my spiritual life. It will enrich every other prayer form, including the Eucharist, which, being the substantial presence of Jesus in Word and Sacrament, is the *source and summit of the spiritual life.* (*Lumen Gentium 11*). PRAYER OF THE HEART happens when I begin to listen to the counsel of God's own Heart and then talk with Father, Son and Holy Spirit from my own heart in my own words. I can go beyond hearing what God is saying to every human being in the liberating public revelation of Sacred Tradition, Sacred Scripture and Magisterial Teaching, to hearing what God wants to tell me personally in my unique, present-moment, circumstances and needs. In PRAYER OF THE HEART I can be strengthened by the harmony of both objective public revelation and subjective personal revelation. I can experience the fulfillment of Jesus' words, *"Abide in my love. If you keep my commandments you will abide in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commandments and abide in his love. These things I have spoken to you, that my joy may be in you, and that your joy may be full."* (*John 15:9-11*). What could be more clear and motivational than these words of Jesus! I, along with every other human being, want to be happy. Aristotle said, *"Happiness is the one thing I can will in and for itself. Everything else is willed for the sake of happiness."* In a world wounded by sin, there is plenty of confusion about the meaning of true happiness. The words of Jesus are light in this darkness. PRAYER OF THE HEART is the gift of prayer that will bring us into the authentic happiness, joy and peace we are all longing for. Next week I promise to go beyond the promise of JOY IN JESUS to some practical wisdom for receiving and living the **JOY OF THE GOSPEL** through the daily discipline of **PRAYER OF THE HEART**.
