EIGHTH GRADE VISITATION

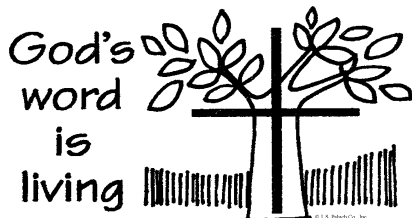
