## DEATH PENALTY FORUM

On Friday, September 14, St Paul Newman Center's Peace and Justice Ministry will host a forum on the death penalty. Our speaker will be Sabrina Butler. She was sentenced to death in Mississippi for killing her baby at age 17. Five years later an appeal court ruled that she was innocent and that the baby died of natural causes. She is the only woman exonerated from death row since 1976. The forum will be held in Cardinal Newman Hall at the Newman Center, 1572 E Barstow, across from Bulldog Stadium. Parking and entrance on 9th St. Doors open at 5:30 and the program begins at 6:00. Refreshments will be served. Admission is free, but a donation will be requested.
